

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps carefully to replace your treadmill running belt:

1. **Disconnect Power:** Unplug the treadmill from the wall outlet.
2. **Remove Motor Cover:** Locate and remove the screws holding the motor cover in place. Carefully lift off the cover.
3. **Loosen Rear Roller Bolts:** At the rear of the treadmill, locate the two bolts that adjust the tension of the walking belt. Turn both bolts counter-clockwise equally to loosen the rear roller and relieve tension on the belt. Continue loosening until the belt can be easily removed.
4. **Remove Old Belt:** Carefully slide the old running belt off the deck and rollers.
5. **Clean Deck:** Thoroughly clean the treadmill deck surface to remove any dust, debris, or old lubricant residue. A clean deck ensures optimal performance and longevity of the new belt.
6. **Install New Belt:** Slide the new Treadmill Doctor running belt onto the deck and around the front and rear rollers. Ensure the belt is centered as much as possible before tensioning.
7. **Tension the Belt:** Gradually tighten the two rear roller bolts clockwise, turning each bolt equally (e.g., half a turn at a time). The belt should be snug but not overly tight. A good test is to lift the edge of the belt in the middle; you should be able to lift it about 2-3 inches.
8. **Center the Belt:** Plug the treadmill back in. Stand on the side rails (do not step on the belt yet) and start the treadmill at a slow speed (e.g., 2-3 mph). Observe the belt's tracking.
 - If the belt drifts to the right, turn the right rear roller bolt clockwise a quarter turn.
 - If the belt drifts to the left, turn the left rear roller bolt clockwise a quarter turn.
 - If the belt is too far to one side, you may need to loosen the opposite bolt slightly (counter-clockwise) and then tighten the bolt on the side it needs to move towards.

Allow the treadmill to run for a few minutes after each adjustment to see the effect. Repeat until the belt runs straight in the center.

9. **Test Operation:** Once centered, walk on the treadmill at various speeds to ensure the belt tracks correctly under load and feels smooth. Make minor adjustments if necessary.
10. **Replace Motor Cover:** Once satisfied with the belt's performance, replace the motor cover and secure it with its screws.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS (POST-INSTALLATION)

After successful installation, follow these guidelines for optimal use:

- **Break-in Period:** Allow the treadmill to run for 10-15 minutes at a moderate speed without a user to help the belt settle.
- **Regular Use:** Use your treadmill as intended. The pre-lubricated belt and included extra lubricant will help maintain smooth operation.
- **Listen for Changes:** Pay attention to any unusual noises or changes in belt tracking, which may indicate a need for adjustment or maintenance.

MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance extends the life of your treadmill belt and ensures safe operation.

- **Lubrication:** Although your belt is pre-lubricated, periodic re-lubrication is essential. Use the included Treadmill Doctor Lube every 3-6 months, or after approximately 150 hours of use, depending on usage frequency.
 - a. **Disconnect Power:** Unplug the treadmill.
 - b. **Lift Belt:** Gently lift one side of the running belt.
 - c. **Apply Lubricant:** Apply a thin line of lubricant down the center of the deck, underneath the belt. Repeat on the other side.
 - d. **Distribute:** Plug in the treadmill and run it at a slow speed (1-2 mph) for 3-5 minutes to evenly distribute the lubricant.
- **Cleaning:** Regularly wipe down the belt and deck edges with a damp cloth to remove dust and sweat. Avoid harsh chemicals.
- **Belt Tension and Tracking:** Periodically check the belt tension and tracking. Adjust as needed following the "Installation Instructions" section.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are solutions to common issues you might encounter:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Belt Slipping	Belt too loose; insufficient lubrication.	Tighten rear roller bolts slightly (equal turns). Apply lubricant if needed.
Belt Drifting to One Side	Uneven belt tension; treadmill not level.	Adjust rear roller bolts to center the belt (refer to Installation section). Ensure treadmill is on a level surface.
Excessive Noise	Lack of lubrication; loose components.	Apply lubricant. Check all visible bolts and screws for tightness.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Belt Sticking/Jerking	Insufficient lubrication; worn deck.	Apply lubricant. If problem persists, the deck may need inspection or replacement by a professional.
