Mr. Coffee BVMC-FM1 Frappe Maker Instruction Manual

Model: BVMC-FM1

1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read all instructions carefully before operating this appliance. Failure to follow these instructions may result in electric shock, fire, or serious personal injury.

- Do not immerse cord, plugs, or the appliance in water or other liquid.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning the appliance.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- The use of accessory attachments not recommended by the appliance manufacturer may result in fire, electric shock, or injury to persons.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Do not use appliance for other than intended use.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Mr. Coffee BVMC-FM1 Frappe Maker is designed to simplify the process of creating delicious blended coffee beverages at home. It features an integrated brewing system and a blending pitcher for convenience.

Components:

- Main Unit (housing brewing and blending mechanisms)
- Removable Blending Pitcher with Lid
- Brew Basket (for coffee grounds)
- Reusable Filter
- Power Button
- Frappe Button
- Blend Button

3. SETUP

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Retain packaging for future storage or transport.
2. **Clean:** Before first use, wash the blending pitcher, lid, and brew basket in warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry. Wipe the exterior of the main unit with a damp cloth.
3. **Placement:** Place the frappe maker on a clean, flat, stable, and heat-resistant surface, away from the edge of the counter. Ensure adequate ventilation around the unit.
4. **Power Connection:** Plug the power cord into a standard electrical outlet.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Making a Frappe:

1. **Prepare Ingredients:** Gather your desired ingredients such as ice, milk, coffee syrup, or brewed coffee. The blending pitcher has a "MAX ICE" line to guide you.
2. **Add Ingredients to Pitcher:** Place the blending pitcher onto the base. Add ice, milk, and any desired syrups or

flavorings to the blending pitcher.

3. **Brew Coffee (Optional):** If you wish to brew coffee directly into the pitcher, open the top lid of the main unit. Insert the brew basket with a reusable filter (or paper filter) and add your desired amount of coffee grounds. Close the lid.
4. **Select Function:**
 - Press the **"Frappe"** button to initiate the brewing and blending cycle for a frappe.
 - Press the **"Blend"** button if you have already added brewed coffee or other liquids and only wish to blend the ingredients.
5. **Blending Process:** The machine will automatically blend the ingredients. The blending cycle will stop once the frappe reaches the desired consistency.
6. **Serve:** Once blending is complete, carefully remove the blending pitcher from the unit. Pour your freshly made frappe into a serving cup.

Note: Always ensure the blending pitcher is securely in place before operating the machine. Do not touch the blades while the machine is in operation.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and extends the life of your Mr. Coffee Frappe Maker.

1. **Unplug:** Always unplug the appliance from the electrical outlet before cleaning.
2. **Wash Removable Parts:** The blending pitcher, lid, and brew basket are dishwasher safe (top rack only) or can be washed by hand in warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly.
3. **Clean Main Unit:** Wipe the exterior of the main unit with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or scouring pads. Never immerse the main unit in water or any other liquid.
4. **Descaling (Periodically):** Over time, mineral deposits can build up. To descale, fill the water reservoir with a mixture of one part white vinegar and two parts water. Run a brew cycle without coffee grounds. Repeat if necessary. Rinse by running two cycles with clean water.
5. **Storage:** Ensure all parts are clean and dry before storing the appliance. Store in a cool, dry place.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Appliance does not turn on.	Not plugged in; power outage; circuit breaker tripped.	Ensure plug is securely in outlet; check household fuse/circuit breaker; try another outlet.
Frappe is not blending smoothly.	Too much ice; not enough liquid; ingredients too large.	Reduce ice quantity; add more liquid (milk, water, coffee); cut larger ingredients into smaller pieces.
Coffee is not brewing.	No water in reservoir; brew basket not properly seated; clogged filter.	Fill water reservoir; ensure brew basket is correctly in place; clean or replace filter.
Leaking from unit.	Blending pitcher not seated correctly; lid not secured.	Ensure blending pitcher is fully locked into base; confirm lid is properly sealed.
