# **NuWave Party Mixer Blender User Manual**

### 1. Introduction

Thank you for choosing the NuWave Party Mixer Blender. This 48-ounce, 400-watt appliance is designed for efficient blending and chopping, making it ideal for preparing a variety of beverages and food items. Its BPA-free pitcher and dual blades ensure reliable performance for your kitchen needs.

## 2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read all instructions carefully before using your NuWave Party Mixer Blender. Failure to follow these safety guidelines may result in injury or damage to the appliance.

- Always unplug the blender from the power outlet before assembling, disassembling, or cleaning.
- Keep hands and utensils out of the pitcher while blending to reduce the risk of severe personal injury.
- Do not blend hot liquids. Allow hot ingredients to cool before processing to prevent pressure buildup and potential injury.
- Ensure the lid is securely in place before operating the blender.
- Never operate the blender with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been

dropped or damaged in any manner.

- This appliance is not intended for use by persons with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Do not immerse the motor base in water or other liquids.
- Use only attachments and accessories recommended by the manufacturer.

### 3. Parts Identification

Familiarize yourself with the components of your NuWave Party Mixer Blender:

- 1. Motor Base: Contains the 400-watt motor and control button.
- 2. **48-ounce Pitcher:** The main blending container, made from BPA-free material, with measurement markings and a handle.
- 3. **Dual Blade Assembly:** Permanently attached to the pitcher's central shaft, designed for chopping and blending.
- 4. Cover Guard with Pour Shield: The lid for the pitcher, designed to prevent splashes and facilitate pouring.
- 5. Storage Lid: An additional lid for storing contents in the pitcher after blending.

# 4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Before first use, wash all parts except the motor base in warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry. The pitcher and lid are dishwasher safe (top rack only).

- 1. Place the motor base on a clean, dry, and stable surface.
- 2. Ensure the pitcher is empty and clean.

- 3. Carefully place the pitcher onto the motor base, aligning the pitcher's bottom with the base. It should sit securely.
- 4. Add your desired ingredients to the pitcher. Do not exceed the 'MAX' fill line.
- 5. Place the cover guard with pour shield onto the pitcher and twist or press down firmly until it is securely locked in place.

# 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The NuWave Party Mixer Blender features a simple push-button operation for effective blending.

- 1. After assembling the blender and adding ingredients (refer to Section 4), plug the power cord into a standard electrical outlet.
- 2. To begin blending, press and hold the power button located on the top of the motor base. The blender will operate as long as the button is held down.
- 3. For best results with ice or hard ingredients, use short pulses rather than continuous blending. This allows

ingredients to fall back onto the blades.

- 4. Blend until desired consistency is achieved.
- 5. Release the power button to stop blending.
- 6. Unplug the blender from the outlet.
- 7. Carefully remove the lid and pour out the contents.

### **Recommended Uses:**

- Iced Beverages: Ideal for smoothies, milkshakes, margaritas, and other crushed ice drinks.
- Food Preparation: Excellent for making salsas, dips, appetizers, and desserts.

### 6. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your blender.

- 1. Always unplug the blender before cleaning.
- 2. Motor Base: Wipe the motor base with a damp cloth. Do not immerse it in water or any other liquid.
- 3. **Pitcher and Lids:** The 48-ounce pitcher and both lids are dishwasher safe (top rack recommended). For hand washing, use warm, soapy water and a non-abrasive sponge. Rinse thoroughly.
- 4. **Blades:** The dual blade assembly is permanently attached to the pitcher. Exercise extreme caution when cleaning around the blades as they are sharp. Use a brush to safely clean around the blades if necessary.
- 5. **Storage:** Ensure all parts are completely dry before storing. Store the blender assembled or with the pitcher inverted over the motor base to save space.

# 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your NuWave Party Mixer Blender, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Blender does not turn on.	Not plugged in; power outlet malfunction; motor base not properly seated; safety mechanism engaged.	Ensure the blender is securely plugged into a working outlet. Check if the pitcher is correctly seated on the motor base.
Ingredients are not blending smoothly.	Too many ingredients; not enough liquid; ingredients are too large or hard.	Reduce the amount of ingredients. Add more liquid. Cut larger ingredients into smaller pieces. Use pulse function for hard items like ice.
Blender leaks from the bottom of the pitcher.	Pitcher not properly sealed to the motor base; pitcher damaged.	Ensure the pitcher is correctly and securely placed on the motor base. Inspect the pitcher for cracks or damage.
Motor smells or overheats.	Overloading the motor; continuous operation for too long.	Unplug the blender and allow it to cool down for at least 15-20 minutes. Reduce the load and use pulse blending.
