# Targus AMW063AP Wireless Blue Trace Mouse User Manual

## INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your Targus AMW063AP Wireless Blue Trace Mouse. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the device to ensure proper functionality and to maximize its lifespan.

The Targus AMW063AP is a wireless mouse featuring Blue Trace technology, offering precise tracking on various surfaces. Its ergonomic and ambidextrous design ensures comfortable use for both left and right-handed individuals. The 2.4GHz wireless technology provides a reliable connection up to 33 feet, and the compact USB receiver can be conveniently stored within the mouse.

## PACKAGE CONTENTS

- Targus AMW063AP Wireless Blue Trace Mouse
- USB Receiver
- AA Battery (may be included or sold separately)

## SETUP

### 1. Battery Installation

The mouse requires one AA battery for operation. A spare battery compartment is also available for convenience.

1. Turn the mouse over to locate the battery compartment cover on the underside.
2. Gently slide or lift the cover to open the compartment.
3. Insert one AA battery, ensuring the positive (+) and negative (-) terminals align correctly with the markings inside the compartment.
4. Close the battery compartment cover securely.

## 2. USB Receiver Connection

The USB receiver provides the wireless connection between the mouse and your computer.

1. Locate the USB receiver, which is typically stored in a slot on the underside of the mouse or packaged separately.
2. Plug the USB receiver into an available USB port on your computer.
3. Your computer should automatically detect and install the necessary drivers. This process may take a few moments.

### 3. Powering On the Mouse

After installing the battery and connecting the USB receiver, turn on the mouse.

- Locate the ON/OFF switch on the underside of the mouse.
- Slide the switch to the "ON" position.
- The mouse should now be ready for use.

### OPERATING THE MOUSE

The Targus AMW063AP mouse offers standard functionality for navigation and interaction with your computer.

- **Left Click:** Use the left button for selecting items, opening files, and primary interactions.
- **Right Click:** Use the right button to access contextual menus and secondary functions.

- **Scroll Wheel:** Roll the scroll wheel up or down to navigate through documents and web pages. The scroll wheel can also be pressed for a middle-click function, depending on software configuration.
- **Blue Trace Technology:** This mouse utilizes Blue Trace technology, allowing it to track accurately on a wide variety of surfaces, including wood, granite, and carpet, without requiring a mouse pad.
- **Wireless Range:** The 2.4GHz wireless connection provides a reliable operating range of up to 33 feet (approximately 10 meters) from the USB receiver.
- **Ergonomic Design:** The mouse is designed to reduce wrist strain and is suitable for both left and right-handed users.

## MAINTENANCE

### Cleaning

To maintain optimal performance and appearance, clean your mouse regularly.

- Disconnect the USB receiver from your computer and turn off the mouse.
- Use a soft, lint-free cloth lightly dampened with water or a mild cleaning solution to wipe the surface of the mouse.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or submerging the mouse in liquid.
- Ensure the optical sensor on the underside is free from dust and debris for accurate tracking.

## Battery Replacement

The mouse features a low power indicator light to signal when the battery needs replacement. The typical battery life is up to 12 months, depending on usage.

- When the low power indicator illuminates, replace the AA battery following the steps outlined in the "Battery Installation" section.
- Dispose of used batteries according to local regulations.

## USB Receiver Storage

The USB receiver can be stored securely within the mouse when not in use or during travel to prevent loss.

- Locate the storage slot on the underside of the mouse.
- Gently push the USB receiver into the slot until it clicks into place.
- To remove, gently pull the receiver out of the slot.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Targus AMW063AP mouse, refer to the following common solutions:

- **Mouse is not responding:**
  - Ensure the mouse is turned ON using the switch on the underside.
  - Check if the battery is correctly installed and has sufficient charge. Replace the battery if necessary.
  - Verify that the USB receiver is securely plugged into a working USB port on your computer. Try a different USB port.
  - Restart your computer.
- **Cursor movement is erratic or inaccurate:**
  - Ensure the optical sensor on the underside of the mouse is clean and free from dust or debris.
  - Try using the mouse on a different surface. While Blue Trace technology works on many surfaces, some highly reflective or transparent surfaces may still affect performance.
  - Ensure there are no strong wireless interference sources nearby.
- **Wireless connection issues:**
  - Reduce the distance between the mouse and the USB receiver.
  - Ensure there are no large metal objects or other electronic devices obstructing the signal path.
  - Unplug and re-plug the USB receiver.
