TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Improper Nailing Depth/Angle:** Ensure the shoe is correctly installed and securely fastened. A loose or improperly seated shoe can affect the nailer's performance.
- **Scratches on Flooring:** Inspect the shoe for any sharp edges, burrs, or embedded debris that could scratch the flooring surface. Clean or replace the shoe if necessary.
- **Shoe Detaches During Use:** Verify that all fasteners are properly tightened. If the shoe continues to detach, inspect the mounting points on the nailer for damage.
