## INTRODUCTION

---

## SETUP AND INSTALLATION

---

Follow these steps to correctly install a new Europarts replacement dust bag into your Goblin Aztec vacuum cleaner.

1. **Power Off and Unplug:** Before beginning, ensure your vacuum cleaner is switched off and unplugged from the power outlet to prevent accidental startup.
2. **Locate Bag Compartment:** Open the dust bag compartment on your Goblin Aztec vacuum cleaner. Refer to your vacuum cleaner's original manual if you are unsure of its location.
3. **Remove Old Bag:** Carefully remove the full dust bag. Most bags have a sealing mechanism to prevent dust from escaping during removal. Dispose of the old bag responsibly according to local waste disposal guidelines.

5. **Close Compartment:** Close the dust bag compartment cover securely. Ensure it latches properly. If the cover does not close completely, the bag may not be installed correctly.

## OPERATING GUIDELINES

---

The Europarts replacement dust bags are designed for single use. For optimal performance and to maintain air quality, it is important to monitor the dust bag's fill level.

- **Check Regularly:** Inspect the dust bag regularly, especially before and after significant cleaning tasks.
- **Replace When Full:** Replace the dust bag when it is approximately two-thirds full, or when the vacuum cleaner's 'bag full' indicator (if present) illuminates. Overfilling the bag can reduce suction power, strain the motor, and potentially lead to dust leakage.
- **Maintain Suction:** A full dust bag is the most common cause of reduced suction. Replacing it promptly will restore your vacuum cleaner's cleaning efficiency.

## MAINTENANCE AND DISPOSAL

---

Proper maintenance primarily involves timely replacement and responsible disposal of the dust bags.

- **Disposal:** Once removed, seal the opening of the used dust bag (if it has a self-sealing tab) and place it directly into a waste bin.
- **Environmental Considerations:** Dispose of used dust bags according to your local municipal waste regulations. These bags are typically made of paper and can be disposed of with general household waste.
- **Storage:** Store unused replacement bags in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and moisture, to preserve their integrity.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

While dust bags are simple components, minor issues can arise. Here are some common troubleshooting

tips:

- **Bag Does Not Fit:** Double-check that you have purchased the correct Europarts replacement bags for your specific Goblin Aztec model. Refer to the compatibility list in the Introduction section. Ensure the cardboard collar is correctly aligned and fully inserted into the vacuum's bag inlet.
- **Reduced Suction After Bag Change:** Verify that the new bag is installed correctly and securely sealed. Check for any obstructions in the vacuum cleaner's hose or nozzle. If the issue persists, consult your vacuum cleaner's main instruction manual.
- **Dust Leaking from Compartment:** Ensure the bag is fully seated and the compartment door is securely closed and latched. A torn or improperly installed bag can cause dust leakage. Replace the bag if it appears damaged.
