### 2.1 Key Features


- **Automatic Needle Threader:** Simplifies the threading process, saving time and effort.

- **Top Drop-in Bobbin:** Provides easy bobbin insertion and monitoring of thread supply.
- **Heavy Duty Metal Frame:** Ensures durability and stability during operation.
- **Bright LED Light:** Illuminates the sewing area for improved visibility.
- **Extension Table:** Provides an expanded, level sewing surface for managing large projects.

The machine features a heavy-duty metal frame, ensuring long-lasting durability with its sturdy interior construction.



## 3. SETUP

### 3.1 Unpacking and Placement

Carefully remove the machine from its packaging. Place the machine on a stable, flat surface with adequate lighting. Ensure there is enough space around the machine for comfortable operation and fabric handling.

### 3.2 Power Connection

Connect the power cord to the machine and then to a suitable electrical outlet. If using the foot pedal, connect it to the designated port on the machine.

### 3.3 Threading the Machine

Proper threading is crucial for optimal stitch quality. Follow the numbered guides on the machine for upper thread path. For the bobbin, utilize the top drop-in bobbin system for easy access and visibility.




Figure 5: A selection of included presser feet, essential for different sewing techniques.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 4.1 Stitch Selection and Adjustment

Use the control panel buttons to navigate and select from the 100 built-in stitches. The LCD screen displays the selected stitch number and recommended settings for length and width. Adjust these settings as needed for your specific fabric and project.

### 4.2 Starting and Stopping Sewing

Press the Start/Stop button to begin or end sewing. Control the sewing speed using the electronic speed control slider. For securing stitches, press the Reverse button.

### 4.3 Needle Position and Automatic Threader

The programmable Needle Up/Down button allows you to set the needle to stop in either the up or down position, which is particularly useful for pivoting fabric or quilting. To use the automatic needle threader, ensure the needle is in its highest position, then follow the guides to engage the threader and pull the thread through the needle eye.




Figure 6: The automatic 1-step buttonhole foot simplifies creating perfectly sized buttonholes.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

### 5.1 Cleaning

Regular cleaning is essential for smooth operation. Turn off and unplug the machine before cleaning. Remove the needle plate and bobbin case. Use the provided lint brush to remove lint and dust from the feed dogs and bobbin area. Do not use compressed air, as it can push lint further into the machine.

### 5.2 Needle Replacement

Replace needles frequently, especially when working with different fabric types or if the needle becomes dull or bent. A dull needle can cause skipped stitches or damage to fabric. Always use SINGER-approved needles.

### 5.3 Oiling

This machine is factory-lubricated and generally does not require user oiling. Refer to the full product manual for specific oiling instructions if necessary, or consult a certified SINGER service technician.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your SINGER 7285Q, please refer to the following common problems and solutions. For more detailed troubleshooting, consult the comprehensive manual available on the SINGER support website.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Skipped Stitches	Incorrect needle, bent needle, improper threading.	Replace needle with correct type/size, re-thread machine completely.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Thread Breaking	Incorrect tension, poor quality thread, needle installed incorrectly.	Adjust tension, use good quality thread, ensure needle is fully inserted and facing correctly.
Fabric Puckering	Tension too tight, incorrect stitch length, wrong needle for fabric.	Loosen upper tension, adjust stitch length, use appropriate needle.
Machine Jamming	Thread tangled in bobbin area, lint buildup, incorrect bobbin insertion.	Clear bobbin area of tangled threads/lint, re-insert bobbin correctly.
