1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the WMF Stelio Citrus Press. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and care of your new appliance. Please read these instructions carefully before first use and keep them for future reference.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and/or injury to persons, including the following:

- Read all instructions.
- Do not immerse the motor base in water or other liquids. Clean only with a damp cloth.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use, before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning.
- Avoid contact with moving parts.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been dropped or damaged in any manner. Contact customer service for examination, repair, or adjustment.
- The use of attachments not recommended or sold by the manufacturer may cause fire, electric shock, or injury.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Always attach plug to appliance first, then plug cord into the wall outlet. To disconnect, turn any control to "off", then remove plug from wall outlet.
- Do not use appliance for other than intended use.
- Ensure the appliance is placed on a stable, flat surface during operation.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The WMF Stelio Citrus Press is designed for efficient juicing of various citrus fruits. It features a durable stainless steel housing and includes two pressing cones for different fruit sizes.

Components:

- Motor Base Unit with Power Cord
- Juice Collection Bowl (Stainless Steel)
- Stainless Steel Sieve/Filter
- Small Pressing Cone
- Large Pressing Cone
- Transparent Dust Cover

4. SETUP

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Retain packaging for storage or future transport.
2. **Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, wash all removable parts (juice collection bowl, sieve, pressing cones, dust cover) in warm soapy water, rinse thoroughly, and dry. Wipe the motor base unit with a damp cloth.
3. **Assemble:**
 - Place the juice collection bowl onto the motor base unit.
 - Place the stainless steel sieve into the juice collection bowl, ensuring it sits securely.
 - Select the appropriate pressing cone: Use the smaller cone for limes and lemons, and the larger cone for oranges and grapefruits. The larger cone fits directly over the smaller cone.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Prepare Fruit:** Cut citrus fruits in half.
2. **Position Glass:** Place a glass or container under the juice spout. Ensure the spout is in the down position to allow juice to flow directly into the glass.
3. **Juice Extraction:** Place a fruit half onto the pressing cone. Apply gentle downward pressure. The motor will activate automatically and the cone will rotate, extracting juice.
4. **Release Pressure:** Once juicing is complete, release the pressure. The motor will stop.
5. **Repeat:** Continue with remaining fruit halves.

6. CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning ensures the longevity and hygiene of your citrus press.

1. **Unplug:** Always unplug the appliance from the power outlet before cleaning.
2. **Disassemble:** Remove the dust cover, pressing cone(s), stainless steel sieve, and juice collection bowl from the motor base.
3. **Wash Removable Parts:** The juice collection bowl, sieve, pressing cones, and dust cover are dishwasher-safe. Alternatively, they can be washed by hand in warm soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely before reassembly or storage.
4. **Clean Motor Base:** Wipe the motor base unit with a soft, damp cloth. Do not immerse the motor base in water or any other liquid. Do not use abrasive cleaners or scouring pads.
5. **Storage:** Once all parts are clean and dry, reassemble the unit or store the components in a clean, dry place. The transparent dust cover can be placed over the assembled cones to protect them from dust.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your WMF Stelio Citrus Press, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Appliance does not turn on.	Not plugged in; power outage; insufficient pressure on cone.	Ensure the appliance is securely plugged into a working outlet. Check your household's power supply. Apply firm, consistent downward pressure on the fruit.
Poor juice extraction.	Incorrect cone size; fruit not cut properly; sieve clogged.	Use the appropriate pressing cone for the fruit size. Ensure fruit is cut in half. Clean the sieve to remove pulp buildup.
Loud noise during operation.	Parts not assembled correctly; foreign object.	Disassemble and reassemble all parts, ensuring they are securely in place. Check for any foreign objects that may have fallen into the unit.
Juice leaks from base.	Juice collection bowl not seated correctly; spout not fully extended.	Ensure the juice collection bowl is properly seated on the motor base. Verify the spout is fully extended into the pouring position.
