


Image 2: A STONELINE ladle demonstrating the integrated stand feature, designed to keep the utensil head elevated from

- **Skimmer:** Used for lifting foods out of liquids, draining, or removing foam from soups.
- **Whisk:** For blending, stirring, and aerating ingredients.

design.

- **Stains:** While designed to be easy to clean, some highly pigmented foods may leave temporary stains. Prompt cleaning after use can minimize this.
