# Logitech Tablet Keyboard for iPads (Model 920-003676) Instruction Manual

Your guide to setting up and using your Logitech wireless keyboard.

## INTRODUCTION

---

This manual provides detailed instructions for the Logitech Tablet Keyboard, Model 920-003676. This keyboard and stand combination is designed for portability, quick setup, and enhanced typing convenience with your compatible tablet or mobile device.

The Logitech Tablet Keyboard offers a compact, low-profile design for comfortable typing. It includes a carrying case that doubles as a sturdy stand for your iPad, allowing for versatile viewing angles in both landscape and portrait orientations. Enjoy wireless freedom with easy Bluetooth pairing and convenient media control keys at your fingertips.

## 1. SETUP

---

### 1.1 Unpacking and Components

Carefully unpack your Logitech Tablet Keyboard. The package should contain the following items:

- Logitech Tablet Keyboard
- Carrying case with integrated display stand
- Batteries (check packaging for type and quantity, typically AAA)

## **1.2 Battery Installation**

The keyboard requires batteries for operation. Locate the battery compartment, usually on the underside or side of the keyboard. Insert the required batteries, ensuring correct polarity (+/-). Close the battery compartment securely.

*Note: Some models may come with pre-installed batteries or require a specific number of AAA batteries. Refer to the packaging for exact details.*

## **1.3 Powering On the Keyboard**

Locate the power switch on the keyboard. Slide it to the "ON" position. An indicator light should illuminate briefly, signaling that the keyboard is powered on and ready for pairing.

## **1.4 Pairing with Your Device (Bluetooth)**

The Logitech Tablet Keyboard connects wirelessly via Bluetooth. Follow these steps to pair it with your iPad, iPhone, or iPod touch:

1. Ensure your keyboard is powered on and within 30 feet (approximately 9 meters) of your device.
2. On your iPad, iPhone, or iPod touch, go to **Settings > Bluetooth**.
3. Make sure Bluetooth is turned **On**.
4. The device will search for available Bluetooth devices. Look for "Logitech Keyboard" or a similar name in the list.
5. Tap on the keyboard's name to initiate the pairing process.
6. Your device may display a passkey. Type this passkey on the Logitech keyboard and press **Enter**.
7. Once paired, the keyboard will appear as "Connected" in your device's Bluetooth settings.

*Note: Actual wireless range may vary based on usage, settings, and environmental conditions.*

## 1.5 Setting Up the Stand

The carrying case for your keyboard also functions as a versatile stand for your tablet:

- Open the carrying case and position it to form a stable stand.
- Place your iPad into the stand's groove.
- Adjust the iPad's position for optimal viewing in either landscape or portrait orientation.

## 2. OPERATING THE KEYBOARD

---

### 2.1 Basic Typing

Once paired, you can use the Logitech Tablet Keyboard for all typing functions on your device. The keyboard features a standard QWERTY layout, similar to a laptop keyboard, for a familiar typing experience.

### 2.2 Media Control Keys

The keyboard includes dedicated media control keys for quick access to audio and video functions. These keys allow you to:

- **Play/Pause:** Control media playback.
- **Volume Up/Down:** Adjust the audio volume.
- **Mute:** Silence audio output.

Refer to the keyboard layout for the exact location of these keys.

### 2.3 Special Function Keys

The keyboard may include additional function keys (e.g., Home button, Search, Lock Screen) specific to iOS devices. These keys provide shortcuts to common tablet functions.

## 3. MAINTENANCE

---

### 3.1 Cleaning the Keyboard

To clean your keyboard, gently wipe the keys and surfaces with a soft, damp, lint-free cloth. Avoid using abrasive cleaners, solvents, or aerosol sprays directly on the keyboard.

### 3.2 Battery Replacement

When the battery indicator light signals low power or if the keyboard becomes unresponsive, it's time to replace the batteries. Follow the battery installation steps (Section 1.2) to replace them with fresh ones. Ensure you use the correct battery type and quantity as specified on the packaging or in the product specifications.

*Tip: Turn off the keyboard when not in use to conserve battery life.*

## 4. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

### 4.1 Keyboard Not Pairing

- **Check Power:** Ensure the keyboard is powered on and has sufficient battery charge.
- **Bluetooth On:** Verify that Bluetooth is enabled on your iPad, iPhone, or iPod touch.
- **Proximity:** Make sure the keyboard is within the 30-foot (9-meter) wireless range of your device.
- **Re-pair:** If previously paired, try "forgetting" the device in your Bluetooth settings and then re-pairing it.
- **Restart Devices:** Restart both your tablet/phone and the keyboard.

### 4.2 Keys Not Responding or Sticking

- **Battery Check:** Low batteries can cause intermittent key response. Replace batteries if needed.
- **Clean Keys:** Dust or debris under the keys can cause sticking. Gently clean around the affected keys.
- **Reconnection:** Disconnect and reconnect the Bluetooth connection.

### 4.3 Intermittent Connection

- **Interference:** Other wireless devices or strong electromagnetic fields can cause interference. Move closer to your device or away from potential interference sources.
- **Battery Level:** Ensure batteries are not low.
