# Milenco Aero 4 Universal Towing Mirrors

## USER MANUAL

### 1. Product Overview

---

The Milenco Aero 4 Universal Towing Mirrors are designed to provide an extended field of view for safe towing of caravans, RVs, and travel trailers. This set includes two convex mirrors with extra-long arms (approximately 41cm) compared to standard models, ensuring excellent visibility even with wider towed vehicles up to 2.5 meters. Engineered for universal fit, these mirrors are compatible with most cars, 4x4s, and vans manufactured from 1995 onwards. They feature a robust, flexible clamping system for secure attachment and minimal vibration.

### 2. Setup and Installation

---

Proper installation is crucial for the stability and effectiveness of your towing mirrors. Follow these steps carefully:

1. **Prepare the Vehicle Mirror:** Ensure the surface of your vehicle's existing side mirror housing is clean and free of debris.
2. **Attach the Clamp:** Position the flexible clamping system of the Milenco Aero 4 mirror onto the edge of your vehicle's side mirror. The clamps are designed to grip securely without damaging the mirror housing.
3. **Tighten the Thumb Wheels:** Carefully tighten the thumb wheels on the clamping mechanism. Tighten them evenly until the mirror is firmly secured and does not wobble. Do not overtighten, as this may cause damage.
4. **Adjust Mirror Arm:** The mirror arm can be adjusted to achieve the desired extension. Ensure it is locked into place once positioned.
5. **Verify Stability:** Gently tug on the installed mirror to confirm it is securely attached and stable. Repeat the process for the second mirror on the opposite side of the vehicle.

### 3. Operation and Adjustment

---

Once installed, adjust the mirror head to optimize your rear and side visibility. The convex lens provides a wider field of view, which is essential for monitoring your towed vehicle and surrounding traffic. Before driving, ensure both mirrors are angled correctly to eliminate blind spots as much as possible.

- **Mirror Head Adjustment:** The mirror head can be manually tilted and swiveled to achieve the best viewing angle.
- **Field of View:** Utilize the convex mirror surface to gain a comprehensive view of the area behind and alongside your caravan or trailer. Objects in convex mirrors are closer than they appear.

## 4. Maintenance and Care

---

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Milenco Aero 4 Towing Mirrors, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Clean the mirror surfaces and plastic components with a soft cloth and mild soap and water. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents that could damage the mirror or plastic.
- **Inspection:** Regularly inspect the clamping mechanism, thumb wheels, and mirror arms for any signs of wear, damage, or looseness. Ensure all parts are secure before each use.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the mirrors in their provided carry case in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight. This protects them from scratches and environmental damage.

## 5. Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your Milenco Aero 4 Towing Mirrors, consider the following common problems and solutions:

- **Excessive Vibration:**
  - Ensure the thumb wheels are tightened securely and evenly.
  - Verify that the mirror's clamping pads are making full contact with your vehicle's mirror housing.
  - Check for any debris or obstructions between the clamp and the vehicle mirror.
- **Difficulty Achieving Stable Fit:**
  - Confirm that the mirrors are positioned correctly on the vehicle's mirror housing, allowing the clamps to grip effectively.
  - Some vehicle mirror shapes may require slight adjustments to the clamp's angle for optimal grip.
- **Poor Visibility:**
  - Re-adjust the mirror head's angle to maximize your field of view.
  - Ensure the mirror surface is clean and free from smudges or dirt.
