INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the proper use and care of your Skagen Men's Melbye Watch, Model SKW6007. This timepiece features a 40mm titanium case, a matte dial with three-hand quartz movement, and a day-date display. The watch is completed with a 28mm steel mesh strap and is water-resistant up to 50 meters (5 ATM).

SETUP

Setting Time and Date


1. **Pull the Crown:** Gently pull the crown (the small knob on the side of the watch case) out to the first or second position.
2. **Set the Date:** If your watch has a date function, pull the crown to the first position and turn it clockwise or counter-clockwise to adjust the date.
3. **Set the Time:** Pull the crown to the second position. Turn the crown to move the hands clockwise until the correct time is displayed. Ensure you account for AM/PM if setting the date.
4. **Push the Crown In:** Once the time and date are set, push the crown back into its original position to start the watch movement.

Adjusting the Mesh Band

The mesh band features a self-adjustable safety buckle closure for a customized fit. Follow these steps to

adjust the band length:

Mesh Band Instructions



TO SECURE THE BAND: HOOK – SNAP - CLASP

Pull the hook over the pin, snap the flat clasp closed, then close the security clasp.

1. **Open the Clasp:** Locate the small lever on the underside of the clasp. Use a small, flat tool (like a screwdriver or a paperclip) to gently lift this lever to unlock the clasp mechanism.
2. **Slide the Clasp:** Once unlocked, you can slide the clasp along the mesh band to your desired length.
3. **Secure the Clasp:** Press the lever back down firmly until it clicks into place, securing the clasp at the new position.
4. **Fasten the Band:** To wear the watch, pull the hook over the pin, snap the flat clasp closed, then close the security clasp. Ensure all parts are securely fastened to prevent accidental opening.

OPERATING YOUR WATCH

Your Skagen Melbye watch is designed for reliable timekeeping with its accurate quartz movement. It features a three-hand display (hour, minute, second) and a rectangular display for the day and date.

- **Time Display:** The hour and minute hands indicate the current time. The second hand provides continuous time measurement.
- **Day and Date Display:** The unique rectangular display shows the current day of the week and the date. This feature automatically advances daily.
- **Water Resistance:** The watch is water-resistant up to 50 meters (5 ATM), making it suitable for short periods of recreational swimming in shallow water. It is *not* recommended for diving, snorkeling, or high-impact water sports. Avoid operating the crown while the watch is wet.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning Your Watch

To maintain the appearance of your watch, regularly wipe the case and band with a soft, dry cloth. For the mesh band, a slightly damp cloth can be used, followed by immediate drying. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

Battery Replacement

The watch is powered by one Lithium Metal battery. When the watch stops or the second hand begins to skip, it indicates that the battery needs replacement. It is highly recommended to have the battery replaced by a qualified watch technician to ensure the watch's water resistance is maintained and to prevent damage to the movement or case back gasket.

Water Resistance Guidelines

While your watch is water-resistant to 50 meters (5 ATM), proper care is essential:

- Do not operate the crown or pushers when the watch is wet or submerged.
- Avoid exposing the watch to extreme temperature changes (e.g., hot showers followed by cold water).
- After exposure to saltwater, rinse the watch with fresh water and dry it thoroughly.
- Water resistance is not a permanent condition and may diminish over time. Have the water resistance checked periodically by a professional, especially after battery changes.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Watch not running	Battery depleted; Crown pulled out.	Replace battery (professional service recommended); Push crown fully in.
Incorrect time/date	Time/date not set correctly; Crown accidentally pulled out.	Refer to 'Setting Time and Date' section; Push crown fully in.
Band feels loose/tight	Band not adjusted to wrist size.	Refer to 'Adjusting the Mesh Band' section.
Condensation under crystal	Exposure to extreme temperature changes or compromised water resistance.	Seek professional service immediately to prevent internal damage.




Image: A visual guide for men's watch case sizes and thickness, helping to understand the 40mm case of the Melbye watch.
