## 1. INTRODUCTION

The NEC NP-UM330X is an ultra short throw projector designed for educational and corporate environments. It features 3300 lumens brightness and a short throw distance, minimizing shadows and glare. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient use of your projector. Key features include a powerful 16W speaker, closed captioning, and RJ-45 for network management. Connectivity options include dual HDMI, VGA, and a microphone input.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read all safety instructions before operating the projector to prevent injury or damage to the unit.

- **Do not** look directly into the projector lens when the lamp is on. The intense light can cause eye damage.
- **Do not** block the ventilation openings. Overheating can cause malfunction or fire.
- **Do not** place the projector on an unstable cart, stand, or table. It may fall, causing serious injury to a child or adult, and serious damage to the appliance.
- **Do not** expose the projector to rain or moisture to reduce the risk of fire or electric shock.
- Refer all servicing to qualified service personnel.

## 4. SETUP

---

### 4.1 Physical Placement

The NP-UM330X is an ultra short throw projector designed to be mounted close to the projection surface, typically directly above the screen. This placement helps eliminate shadows and glare.

- Mount the projector securely to a wall or ceiling mount designed for ultra short throw projectors.
- Ensure the projection surface is flat and smooth for optimal image quality.
- Maintain adequate clearance around the projector for ventilation.

### 4.2 Connecting Devices

Connect your source devices to the projector using the appropriate ports.

1. **HDMI:** Connect a computer, Blu-ray player, or other HDMI-enabled device to one of the dual HDMI ports.
2. **VGA:** Connect a computer using a VGA cable to the VGA input port.
3. **Audio:** For external audio sources, use the audio input jacks. The projector also features a microphone input to amplify the presenter's voice.
4. **Network (RJ-45):** Connect an Ethernet cable to the RJ-45 port for remote management over a network.
5. **Power:** Connect the power cord to the projector and then to a grounded electrical outlet.

### 4.3 Powering On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press the power button on the projector or the remote control. The power indicator light will illuminate.
- **To Power Off:** Press the power button again. A confirmation message may appear. Press the power button a second time to confirm shutdown. Allow the projector to cool down before unplugging it.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### 5.1 Basic Operation

- **Input Selection:** Use the "Input" button on the remote or projector control panel to cycle through available input sources (HDMI1, HDMI2, VGA, etc.).
- **Menu Navigation:** Use the "Menu" button to access the on-screen display (OSD). Navigate using the arrow keys and confirm selections with the "Enter" button.
- **Volume Control:** Adjust the volume of the built-in 16W speaker using the volume buttons on the remote control.

### 5.2 Image Adjustment

Optimize the projected image for clarity and quality.

- **Focus:** Adjust the focus ring on the lens until the image is sharp.
- **Keystone Correction:** If the image appears trapezoidal, use the keystone correction function in the OSD menu to square the image.
- **Aspect Ratio:** Select the appropriate aspect ratio (e.g., 4:3 native, 16:9) from the OSD menu to match your content.
- **Brightness/Contrast:** Adjust these settings in the OSD menu to suit your viewing environment.

### 5.3 Interactive System (Optional)

The NP-UM330X can be integrated with the optional NP02Wi eBeam interactive system to create a complete interactive projection solution. Refer to the NP02Wi eBeam manual for detailed setup and operation instructions for the interactive features.

### 5.4 Network Management

The RJ-45 port allows for remote management of the projector over a network. This includes monitoring projector status, controlling power, and adjusting settings from a connected computer. Consult the network guide on the provided CD-ROM for detailed instructions on configuring network settings and using management software.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your projector.

### 6.1 Lamp Replacement

The projector lamp has a finite lifespan. When the lamp life indicator appears, replace the lamp promptly. Refer to the full user manual on the CD-ROM for detailed lamp replacement procedures. Always use genuine NEC replacement lamps.

- Allow the projector to cool completely before attempting lamp replacement.
- Disconnect the power cord before opening the lamp cover.
- Dispose of used lamps according to local regulations.

### 6.2 Filter Cleaning

The air filter prevents dust from entering the projector. Clean the filter regularly (e.g., every 100 hours of use) to maintain proper ventilation and prevent overheating.

- Turn off the projector and disconnect the power cord.
- Locate the air filter cover, typically on the side or bottom of the projector.
- Remove the filter and clean it with a soft brush or vacuum cleaner. Do not wash the filter with water.
- Reinsert the clean filter and close the cover securely.

### 6.3 General Cleaning

- **Projector Casing:** Wipe the exterior with a soft, dry cloth. For stubborn dirt, use a cloth lightly dampened with water and a mild detergent, then wipe dry.
- **Lens:** Gently clean the lens with a lens cleaning cloth or lens paper. Avoid using abrasive materials or harsh chemicals.
