# Kenneth Cole KC9210 Analog Men's Watch User Manual

## INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Kenneth Cole KC9210 Analog Men's Watch. This timepiece features an automatic movement, which is powered by the natural motion of your wrist. This manual provides essential information for the proper setup, operation, maintenance, and care of your watch to ensure its longevity and accurate performance.

## SETUP

### Setting the Time

1. Gently pull the crown (the small knob on the side of the watch case) out to its outermost position.
2. Rotate the crown clockwise or counter-clockwise to set the hour and minute hands to the correct time.
3. Once the time is set, push the crown back into its original position against the watch case.

### Winding the Automatic Movement

Your KC9210 watch is powered by an automatic movement. It does not require a battery change. The watch is wound by the motion of your wrist during daily wear. If the watch has stopped or its power reserve is low, you can manually wind it:

- With the crown in its normal, pushed-in position, rotate it clockwise approximately 20-30 times. This will build up an initial power reserve.
- Wear the watch regularly to maintain its power reserve. If worn daily, manual winding should not be frequently necessary.

### Band Adjustment

The stainless steel band can be adjusted for a comfortable fit. It is recommended to have the band adjusted by a professional jeweler or watch technician to avoid damage to the links or clasp mechanism.

## OPERATING YOUR WATCH

The Kenneth Cole KC9210 is an analog watch with an automatic movement. It displays time using hour, minute, and second hands on a multi-color dial.

- **Automatic Movement:** The watch is powered by the kinetic energy generated by your arm's motion. Consistent daily wear will keep the watch running accurately.
- **Power Reserve:** If the watch is not worn for an extended period (typically 36-40 hours), it may stop.

Simply wind it manually as described in the Setup section and reset the time if necessary.

## MAINTENANCE

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### Cleaning

- Wipe the watch case and band regularly with a soft, dry cloth to remove dust and smudges.
- For stainless steel bands, a slightly damp cloth can be used, followed by immediate drying. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

### Storage

- When not wearing your watch, store it in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Avoid storing the watch near strong magnetic fields, as these can affect the accuracy of the automatic movement.

### Water Resistance

While your watch may offer some level of water resistance, it is generally recommended to avoid prolonged exposure to water, such as swimming or showering, unless explicitly stated otherwise for your specific model. Always ensure the crown is fully pushed in to maintain any water resistance.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Watch Not Running:** If the watch has stopped, it likely needs to be wound. Manually wind the watch by rotating the crown 20-30 times while it's in the pushed-in position. If it still does not run after winding and wearing, it may require professional service.
- **Time Inaccuracy:** Minor variations in timekeeping are normal for mechanical watches. However, if your watch is consistently gaining or losing significant time, it may need adjustment. Avoid exposing the watch to strong magnetic fields, which can affect accuracy.

- **Crown Not Operating:** If the crown is stiff or difficult to pull out/push in, do not force it. Contact a qualified watch technician for assistance.
