INTRODUCTION

The Cuisinart GR-11 Griddler 3-in-1 Grill and Panini Press is a versatile kitchen appliance designed for preparing a variety of meals. This manual provides essential information for safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and care of your Griddler.

KEY FEATURES

- **3-in-1 Functionality:** Operates as a contact grill, panini press, and opens flat to double the cooking surface for griddle-style cooking.
- **Adjustable Floating Hinge:** Accommodates various food thicknesses for even cooking and toasting.
- **Removable & Reversible Grill Plates:** Nonstick for easy food release and dishwasher-safe for convenient cleanup.
- **Integrated Drip Tray:** Collects grease and can be removed for easy cleaning, promoting healthier cooking.
- **Indicator Lights:** "Power On" and "Ready to Cook" lights provide clear operational status.
- **Adjustable Front Feet:** Allows for tilting the unit to enhance grease drainage when grilling.
- **Brushed Stainless Steel Housing:** Durable construction with a sleek finish.

SETUP

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all packaging materials and any promotional labels or stickers from your Griddler.
2. **Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, wipe the base and handle with a clean, damp cloth. Wash the removable grill plates and drip tray in warm, soapy water, then rinse and dry thoroughly. The plates are dishwasher-safe.
3. **Placement:** Place the Griddler on a clean, flat, stable, and heat-resistant surface. Ensure there is adequate ventilation around the unit.
4. **Drip Tray Installation:** Slide the integrated drip tray into its designated slot at the front of the unit.
5. **Plate Installation:** Ensure the grill plates are correctly seated and locked into place. Press the plate release buttons to ensure they are securely fastened.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

General Operation

1. **Preheating:** Plug the Griddler into a standard electrical outlet. The "Power On" indicator light will illuminate. Allow the unit to preheat until the "Ready to Cook" indicator light turns green.
2. **Food Placement:** Carefully place food onto the preheated cooking surface.
3. **Cooking:** Cook food according to recipe or desired doneness. The floating hinge will adjust to the thickness of your food.
4. **Removal:** Use heat-resistant, non-metallic utensils to remove cooked food.
5. **Power Off:** Unplug the unit from the electrical outlet when cooking is complete.

Panini Press / Contact Grill Mode

This mode is ideal for grilling sandwiches, burgers, chicken, and thin cuts of meat, cooking both sides simultaneously.

- Ensure the unit is in the closed position.
- Preheat the Griddler until the "Ready to Cook" light is green.
- Place food on the bottom grill plate and gently lower the top plate.
- The floating hinge will adapt to the food's thickness.

Open Grill / Griddle Mode

To use the Griddler as an open grill or griddle, press the hinge release button on the right side of the unit and gently push the top cover back until it lies flat, doubling your cooking surface. This is suitable for cooking larger quantities or items like pancakes, eggs, or multiple pieces of meat.

- Press the hinge release button located on the right side of the unit.
- Gently push the top cover back until it rests flat, creating two open cooking surfaces.
- Preheat the Griddler until the "Ready to Cook" light is green.
- Place food on both cooking surfaces as desired.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

1. **Cool Down:** Always unplug the Griddler and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.
2. **Drip Tray:** Remove the drip tray and discard collected grease. Wash the drip tray in warm, soapy water or place it in the dishwasher.
3. **Removable Plates:** Press the plate release buttons to remove the grill plates. Wash them in warm, soapy water or place them in the dishwasher. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or metal scouring pads, as these can damage the nonstick coating.
4. **Base and Housing:** Wipe the exterior of the Griddler with a soft, damp cloth. Never immerse the base in water or other liquids.
5. **Storage:** Ensure all parts are clean and dry before storing. The Griddler can be stored in its closed position.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If your Cuisinart GR-11 Griddler is not functioning as expected, please review the following common issues:

- **Unit Not Turning On:** Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a functional electrical outlet.
- **"Ready to Cook" Light Not Illuminating:** Allow sufficient time for the unit to preheat. If the issue persists, ensure the plates are correctly installed.
- **Uneven Cooking:** Ensure food is evenly distributed on the cooking surface. For contact grilling, verify the floating hinge is properly engaging with the food.
- **Food Sticking:** Ensure the nonstick plates are clean and consider lightly greasing them with cooking spray or oil before adding food.
