Medisana FS-52E Foot Spa with Reflexology, Electric Foot Bath, Heating Function

INSTRUCTION MANUAL

1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Medisana FS-52E Foot Spa. This device is designed to provide a relaxing and invigorating foot massage experience. It combines three functions: a bubble massage, a vibration massage, and a heating function to maintain water temperature. This manual provides important information for the safe and effective use of your foot spa.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read all safety instructions carefully before using the Medisana FS-52E Foot Spa. Failure to follow these instructions may result in electric shock, fire, or serious injury.

- Always use the massager in a dry environment to prevent electric shock.
- Do not immerse the massager in water.
- Allow the massager to cool down before storing it.
- Avoid using the massager if you have medical conditions or injuries that could be affected by heat or massage.
- Consult a healthcare professional before use if you are pregnant, suffer from diabetes, or have any other health concerns.
- Keep the massager out of reach of children and pets.
- Ensure the power cord is not damaged and is placed safely to avoid tripping hazards.
- Do not use the appliance if it has been dropped or damaged.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Medisana FS-52E Foot Spa is designed for ease of use and effective foot relaxation. Familiarize yourself with its components:

- **Basin:** The main reservoir for water.
- **Control Panel:** Located at the top, with a single button to select functions.
- **Reflexology Rollers:** Two removable rollers for targeted foot massage.
- **Massage Nubs:** Integrated nubs on the basin floor for additional foot stimulation.
- **Splash Guard:** Integrated design to minimize water splashing.

4. SETUP

1. Place the foot spa on a flat, stable, and dry surface. Ensure it is near a power outlet and on a surface that can tolerate potential water splashes.
2. Fill the basin with warm water. Do not exceed the maximum fill line indicated inside the basin. The

device is designed to maintain the water temperature, not to heat cold water rapidly.

3. Plug the power cord into a suitable electrical outlet.
4. Ensure your feet are clean before placing them into the foot spa.

5. OPERATION

The Medisana FS-52E offers three functions controlled by a single button on the control panel.

1. Place your feet comfortably into the filled basin.
2. Press the red power button on the control panel to select your desired function:
 - **Setting 0:** Off
 - **Setting 1:** Bubble Massage + Heat (The device will generate bubbles and maintain the water temperature.)
 - **Setting 2:** Bubble Massage + Vibration Massage + Heat (All three functions are active: bubbles, vibration, and heat maintenance.)
3. For enhanced reflexology, you can move your feet over the integrated massage nubs and the removable reflexology rollers.

4. Enjoy your foot spa session. Recommended session duration is 10-20 minutes.
5. To turn off the device, press the power button until it reaches "0" or unplug it from the power outlet.

The foot spa can also be used for a gentle massage without water. In this case, ensure the heating function is not active to prevent damage.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1. Cleaning

1. Always unplug the device before cleaning.
2. Empty the water from the basin.
3. Wipe the interior and exterior surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals.
4. Ensure no water enters the electrical components.
5. Allow the device to dry completely before storage.

6.2. Storage

- Store the foot spa in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and moisture.
- Do not wrap the power cord tightly around the device, as this can damage the cord.

- Keep out of reach of children.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Device does not turn on.	Not plugged in; power outlet faulty; device damaged.	Ensure the device is securely plugged in. Test the outlet with another appliance. If still not working, contact customer support.
Bubbles/Vibration not working.	Incorrect function selected; air vents blocked.	Check that setting 1 or 2 is selected. Ensure the air vents at the bottom of the basin are clear.
Water is not staying warm.	Initial water temperature too low; heating element malfunction.	Start with warm water. The device maintains temperature, it does not rapidly heat cold water. If the issue persists, contact customer support.
Excessive noise.	Normal operation for vibration; unstable surface.	Some noise is normal during vibration. Ensure the device is on a stable, flat surface. Placing a mat underneath may reduce noise.
