SETUP

- 1. Unpackaging:** Carefully remove the NUK Bottle Drying Wand from its packaging. Inspect the product for any visible damage.
- 2. Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, it is recommended to wash the drying wand. You can hand wash it with warm soapy water or place it in the dishwasher. Ensure it is thoroughly rinsed.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- Regular Cleaning:** To maintain hygiene, clean the drying wand regularly. It can be hand washed with warm, soapy water or placed in the dishwasher.
- Drying the Wand:** After cleaning or use, always store the wand upright on its base to allow the microfiber head to air dry completely. This helps prevent mildew and bacterial growth.
- Inspection:** Periodically inspect the microfiber head for wear and tear. While durable, excessive use may reduce its absorbency over time.
- Storage:** Store the drying wand in a clean, dry place when not in use.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Drying head detaches from handle during use.	The drying head may not be securely attached or has loosened over time.	Gently twist the drying head back onto the handle until it feels secure. Avoid excessive force when drying bottles.
Wand is not drying bottles effectively.	The microfiber head may be saturated with water or worn out.	Ensure the wand is completely dry before use. If absorbency has significantly decreased, consider replacing the wand. The wand is designed to dry approximately 20 bottles before needing to dry itself.
Unpleasant odor from the drying head.	Incomplete drying of the microfiber head after use, leading to mildew.	Thoroughly wash the wand and ensure it air dries completely in an upright position after every use and cleaning.




Image 4: The NUK Bottle Drying Wand shown with its approximate height measurement of 11 inches (27 cm).



