1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Rough Country 1.25" Body Lift Kit (RC608) is designed to provide additional tire clearance for 1987-1996 Jeep Wrangler YJ models with manual transmissions. This kit offers a 1.25-inch lift, allowing for larger tires and an enhanced vehicle stance.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Rough Country strongly recommends that all lift systems be installed by a certified technician. Proper knowledge of Rough Country instructions, suspension procedures, and post-installation checks are crucial. Installation without the necessary expertise may compromise the integrity and operating safety of the vehicle.

It is the buyer's responsibility to ensure all bolts and nuts are checked for tightness after the first 500 miles of driving, and subsequently every 1,000 miles. Additionally, the wheel alignment, steering system, suspension, and driveline systems must be inspected by a qualified, professional mechanic at least every 3,000 miles.

3. PARTS LIST

Verify that all components listed below are present in your kit before beginning installation:

- Body Lift Pucks (Fiberglass Reinforced Nylon)
- Heavy Duty Grade 8 Hardware (various bolts, nuts, washers)

4. INSTALLATION GUIDELINES

This section provides general guidelines. Refer to the detailed instructions provided with your kit for specific, step-by-step procedures. Professional installation is highly recommended.

Pre-Installation:

- Ensure the vehicle is on a level surface and properly secured.
- Disconnect the battery.
- Review all instructions and identify all components.
- Confirm vehicle compatibility (1987-1996 Jeep Wrangler YJ, manual transmission).

General Procedure:

1. Loosen body mount bolts.
2. Carefully lift the vehicle body from the frame, ensuring no lines or hoses are stretched or damaged.
3. Insert the fiberglass reinforced nylon body lift pucks between the body and the frame at each mounting point.
4. Install the provided Heavy Duty Grade 8 hardware, ensuring proper torque specifications are met.
5. Reconnect any disconnected components and perform necessary adjustments (e.g., steering linkage, shifter linkage).

Post-Installation:

- Perform a thorough inspection of all installed components.
- Check for proper clearance and functionality of all moving parts.
- Have a professional perform a wheel alignment.
- Re-torque all bolts after the first 500 miles and periodically thereafter.

5. OPERATING CONSIDERATIONS

Installing a body lift kit alters the vehicle's center of gravity and handling characteristics. Drivers should be aware of these changes and adjust their driving style accordingly.

- Increased vehicle height may affect stability, especially during cornering or in windy conditions.
- Be mindful of overhead clearances in parking garages, drive-thrus, and other low-clearance areas.
- Braking distances may be slightly altered.
- Off-road capabilities are enhanced, but always drive within your skill level and the vehicle's limits.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance is essential to ensure the continued safe operation and longevity of your body lift kit and vehicle.

- **Bolt Torque Checks:** As per the safety information, re-check the torque on all body mount bolts after the first 500 miles and every 1,000 miles thereafter.
- **Visual Inspection:** Periodically inspect the body lift pucks and hardware for any signs of wear, damage, or corrosion.
- **Professional Inspections:** Ensure regular inspections of the wheel alignment, steering system, suspension, and driveline systems by a qualified mechanic every 3,000 miles.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you experience any issues after installing your Rough Country Body Lift Kit, consider the following:

- **Unusual Noises:** Check all body mount bolts for proper torque. Inspect for any components rubbing or interfering with each other.
- **Steering Issues:** Verify that the steering linkage has been properly adjusted and secured. A professional alignment is crucial after installation.
- **Shifter Linkage Problems:** Ensure the shifter linkage has been correctly adjusted to accommodate the body lift.
- **Vibrations:** Check driveline angles and ensure all components are properly aligned and torqued.




