INTRODUCTION

SETUP

Unpacking

Carefully remove the Tupperware Rock N Serve container and its lid from the packaging. Inspect for any signs of damage. If any damage is found, do not use the product and contact customer support.

Initial Cleaning

Before first use, wash the container and lid thoroughly with warm soapy water or place them in the dishwasher. Rinse well and dry completely.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Filling the Container

Place food items into the container. Ensure not to overfill, leaving adequate space for the lid to seal properly.

Sealing the Lid

Place the lid onto the container. Press down firmly around the edges to create a secure seal. Ensure the vent cap is properly seated.

Microwave Reheating

1. Ensure the vent cap on the lid is open before placing the container in the microwave. This allows steam to escape during reheating, preventing pressure buildup.
2. Place the container in the microwave.
3. Reheat food according to your microwave's instructions and food type.
4. After reheating, carefully remove the container from the microwave using oven mitts if hot.
5. Close the vent cap for transport or storage.

Important: Always open the vent cap when microwaving to prevent pressure buildup and potential damage to the container or microwave.

Freezer Use

The Tupperware Rock N Serve container is safe for freezer use. When removing from the freezer, it is recommended to run warm water over the vent prior to opening or microwaving to prevent damage to the vent mechanism due to freezing.

Serving

The container is designed to be presentable for direct serving. Simply remove the lid and serve your reheated meal.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

- The Tupperware Rock N Serve container and lid are dishwasher safe. Place them on the top rack for best results.
- Alternatively, wash by hand with warm water and mild dish soap. Use a soft sponge or cloth to avoid scratching.
- Rinse thoroughly and allow to air dry completely before storing to prevent odors or mildew.

Storage

Store the container and lid separately or with the lid loosely placed on top to allow for air circulation and prevent trapped odors.

Precautions

- Do not use abrasive cleaners or scouring pads, as these can scratch the surface.
- Avoid cutting food directly inside the container with sharp utensils, which may damage the plastic.
- Do not use the container in a conventional oven, on a stovetop, or under a broiler.
- Ensure the vent is open when microwaving to prevent pressure buildup.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Lid difficult to seal or remove.	Food overflow; container or lid warped; vent cap not properly aligned.	Do not overfill. Ensure container and lid are clean and dry. Check for warping; if warped, product may need replacement. Ensure vent cap is correctly positioned.
Food not heating evenly in microwave.	Food density; microwave power settings.	Stir food halfway through reheating. Adjust microwave power or time as needed. Ensure vent is open.
Stains or odors in container.	Strongly colored or odorous foods; improper cleaning.	Wash immediately after use. For stubborn stains/odors, try a paste of baking soda and water, let sit, then wash. Sunlight exposure can also help with stains.
Container appears cloudy or scratched.	Abrasive cleaning; hard water residue; excessive heat.	Use soft sponges and mild detergents. Rinse thoroughly. Ensure vent is open during microwaving.



Cooking Instructions & Timing

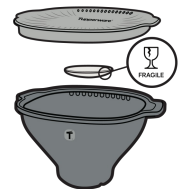
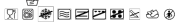
- Remove cover from Microwave Breakfast Maker.
- For poaching, Carefully place Egg inserts inside the Microwave Breakfast Maker, ensuring the opening is facing upward. Fill to water depth with water (1/2 cup). Crack egg(s) into the Egg insert(s).
- If scrambled eggs are desired, no inserts are needed, unless desired. scramble with a spoon before cooking one or two eggs (per insert) for 90 seconds (1:30) (500 watt microwave oven).
- If poached eggs are desired, cook one egg (per insert) for 75 seconds (1:15) with water (3/8 cup microwave oven).
