INTRODUCTION

The Salter 1150 BKDR Digital Kitchen Scales are designed for precise measurement of ingredients in your home or kitchen. Featuring a stylish glass design and an easy-to-read display, these scales offer accurate measurements for both solids and liquids, making your cooking and baking tasks simpler and more efficient.

Key features include:

- **Measure onto Platform:** Allows direct measurement of ingredients onto the glass platform or into a mixing bowl.
- **Aquatronic Function:** Accurately weighs liquids in milliliters (ml) or fluid ounces (fl.oz).
- **Add & Weigh (Tare) Function:** Enables measuring multiple ingredients in the same bowl by resetting the scale to zero after each addition.
- **Easy to Read Display:** Clear digital display with switchable imperial or metric measures.
- **Stylish & Slim Design:** Compact for easy storage and a sleek look on your countertop.

SETUP

Before first use, ensure the scales are placed on a flat, stable surface. The Salter 1150 BKDR scales require 2 AAA batteries, which are included with the product.

1. Locate the battery compartment on the underside of the scales.
2. Open the battery compartment cover.
3. Insert the 2 AAA batteries, ensuring correct polarity (+/-).
4. Close the battery compartment cover securely.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Turning On and Basic Weighing

1. Place the scales on a firm, flat surface.
2. Press the **ON/ZERO** button to turn on the scales. The display will show "8888" and then "0".
3. Place the item to be weighed directly onto the glass platform. The weight will be displayed.

Using the Add & Weigh (Tare) Function

The Add & Weigh function allows you to measure multiple ingredients consecutively in the same bowl without emptying it.

1. Place your first ingredient (or empty bowl) on the scales. Note the weight.
2. Press the **ON/ZERO** button to reset the display to "0".
3. Add the next ingredient. The display will show the weight of only the newly added ingredient.
4. Repeat this process for all subsequent ingredients.

Changing Units (Metric/Imperial & Aquatronic)

The scales can measure in grams (g), ounces (oz), milliliters (ml), and fluid ounces (fl.oz).

1. With the scales on, press the **UNIT** button to cycle through the available measurement units.
2. The Aquatronic function allows for accurate measurement of liquids (water, milk, etc.) by selecting 'ml' or 'fl.oz'.

Auto Shut-Off

To conserve battery life, the scales feature an automatic shut-off function. If left inactive for a period, the scales will turn off automatically.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and accuracy of your Salter Digital Kitchen Scales, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** The glass platform is easy to clean. Wipe the scales with a damp cloth and mild detergent. Do not immerse the scales in water or use abrasive cleaning agents. The scales are not dishwasher compatible.
- **Storage:** Store the scales in a dry place. Their slim design allows for easy storage in a cupboard or

drawer.

- **Battery Replacement:** Replace batteries when the low battery indicator appears on the display. Always use 2 new AAA batteries.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Salter Digital Kitchen Scales, please refer to the following common solutions:

- **Inaccurate Readings:**
 - Ensure the scales are on a flat, stable, and level surface.
 - Check that no objects are touching the scales or the platform during weighing.
 - Verify that the batteries are not low or depleted. Replace if necessary.
- **Display Not Turning On:**
 - Check battery installation and ensure correct polarity.
 - Replace batteries with new ones.
- **"Err" Message on Display:**
 - This usually indicates an overload. Remove the item from the scales immediately to prevent damage.
