For Honda NC700 XA/XAD/S/sad Motorcycles

1. INTRODUCTION

3. INSTALLATION GUIDE

4. USAGE INSTRUCTIONS

Attaching Panniers

1. Align the pannier's mounting points with the corresponding hooks and the upper locking mechanism on the PLX1111 holder.
2. Engage the lower hooks first, then push the pannier firmly against the holder until the upper locking mechanism audibly clicks into place.
3. Verify that the pannier is securely locked by gently attempting to pull it away from the holder.
4. Use the pannier's key to lock the case to the holder, which prevents both accidental detachment and unauthorized removal.

Detaching Panniers

1. Unlock the pannier using its dedicated key.
2. Operate the release lever or button on the pannier. The exact location and mechanism may vary depending on your specific pannier model.
3. Gently pull the pannier away from the holder to remove it.

Important Considerations

- Always distribute weight evenly between panniers to maintain motorcycle balance.
- Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity specified for your panniers or your motorcycle.
- Be aware that adding panniers can affect the motorcycle's handling characteristics and aerodynamics, especially at higher speeds or in crosswinds.

- If applicable, lubricate any moving parts of the pannier attachment mechanism with a suitable, non-corrosive lubricant to ensure smooth and reliable operation.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with the Givi PLX1111 Pannier Holder and provides potential solutions.

Panniers Not Attaching Securely

- **Check Alignment:** Ensure the pannier holder is correctly installed and not bent or misaligned. A misaligned holder can prevent proper pannier engagement.
- **Inspect Mechanism:** Verify that the pannier's locking mechanism and the holder's attachment points are clean and free of any obstructions, dirt, or debris.
- **Verify Compatibility:** Confirm that your specific Givi panniers are compatible with the PLX1111 system.

Loose or Rattling Holder

- **Tighten Fasteners:** Re-check and tighten all mounting bolts and fasteners to the recommended torque specifications. Vibrations during riding can cause bolts to loosen over time.
- **Inspect for Damage:** Carefully inspect the entire frame and all mounting points for any signs of wear, fatigue, or damage that could compromise stability.

Corrosion

- **Clean Regularly:** Clean the pannier holder regularly, especially after riding in wet, humid, or salty conditions, which can accelerate corrosion.
- **Apply Protective Coating:** Consider applying a suitable rust-inhibiting spray or wax to exposed metal surfaces to provide an additional layer of protection.




