INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Conair BB075W Pro Blackbird 2000 Watt Hair Dryer. This professional-grade hair dryer is designed to provide powerful and efficient drying and styling for various hair types. Please read this instruction manual thoroughly before use to ensure safe and optimal performance.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using electrical appliances, especially when children are present, basic safety precautions should always be followed, including the following:

- **DANGER:** Keep away from water. Do not use while bathing or in a shower.
- Always unplug the appliance immediately after using.
- Do not place or store appliance where it can fall or be pulled into a tub or sink.
- Do not place in or drop into water or other liquid.
- If an appliance falls into water, unplug it immediately. Do not reach into the water.
- **WARNING:** To reduce the risk of burns, electrocution, fire, or injury to persons:
- An appliance should never be left unattended when plugged in.
- Close supervision is necessary when this appliance is used by, on, or near children or individuals with certain disabilities.
- Use this appliance only for its intended use as described in this manual. Do not use attachments not recommended by the manufacturer.
- Never operate this appliance if it has a damaged cord or plug, if it is not working properly, or if it has been dropped or damaged, or dropped into water. Return the appliance to an authorized service center for examination and repair.

- Keep the cord away from heated surfaces. Do not pull, twist, or wrap cord around appliance.
- Never block the air openings of the appliance or place it on a soft surface, such as a bed or couch, where the air openings may be blocked. Keep the air openings free of lint, hair, and the like.
- Never use while sleeping.
- Never drop or insert any object into any opening.
- Do not use outdoors or operate where aerosol (spray) products are being used or where oxygen is being administered.
- Do not use an extension cord with this appliance.
- Do not direct hot air toward eyes or other heat-sensitive areas.
- Attachments may be hot during use. Allow them to cool before handling.
- Do not place appliance on any surface while it is operating.
- While using the appliance, keep your hair away from the air inlets.
- Do not use with a voltage converter.

SETUP

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove the hair dryer and all accessories from the packaging.
2. **Inspect:** Check the appliance for any signs of damage. Do not use if damaged.
3. **Plug In:** Insert the plug into a standard electrical outlet (110-125V AC). Ensure the outlet is suitable for the appliance's wattage (2000W).
4. **Test ALCI Safety Plug:** This appliance is equipped with an Appliance Leakage Circuit Interrupter (ALCI) safety plug. To test:
 - Plug in the hair dryer.
 - Press the TEST button on the plug. The RESET button should pop up.
 - Press the RESET button. The RESET button should click in.

- If the RESET button does not click in, or if the TEST button does not cause the RESET button to pop up, do not use the appliance. Return it to the place of purchase or an authorized service center.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Conair BB075W Pro Blackbird Hair Dryer features multiple heat and speed settings for customized styling.

1. **Power On:** After plugging in and testing the ALCI safety plug, slide the ON/OFF switch to the desired speed setting (Low or High).
2. **Select Heat:** Use the heat setting switch to choose between Cool, Warm, or Hot air.
3. **Drying:** Hold the hair dryer at a comfortable distance from your hair. Direct the airflow evenly over sections of your hair.
4. **Styling:** For specific styles, use the appropriate attachments (see "Attachments" section).
5. **Cool Shot:** To set your style, press and hold the cool shot button to release a burst of cool air.
6. **Power Off:** When finished, slide the ON/OFF switch to the "OFF" position and unplug the appliance from the electrical outlet.

ATTACHMENTS

The Conair BB075W Pro Blackbird Hair Dryer includes attachments to enhance your styling experience.

- **Concentrator Nozzle:** For precise drying and styling, attach the concentrator nozzle to direct airflow to specific sections of hair. This is ideal for straightening or smoothing hair.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the life of your hair dryer.

- 1. Cleaning the Air Filter:** The hair dryer features a hinged and removable filter for easy cleaning.
 - Ensure the hair dryer is unplugged and completely cool.
 - Gently open the hinged filter cover at the rear of the dryer.
 - Remove any accumulated lint, dust, or hair from the filter screen.
 - Close the filter cover securely.
- 2. Storage:** When not in use, store the hair dryer in a cool, dry place. Do not wrap the cord tightly around the appliance, as this can damage the cord.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Hair dryer does not turn on.	Not plugged in, ALCI tripped, power outage.	Ensure plug is fully inserted. Press the RESET button on the ALCI plug. Check household circuit breaker.
Airflow is weak or inconsistent.	Blocked air intake filter.	Unplug the dryer and clean the removable air filter as described in the Maintenance section.
Hair dryer overheats and shuts off.	Overheating protection activated due to blocked airflow or prolonged use.	Unplug the dryer and allow it to cool for 10-15 minutes. Clean the air filter. Ensure air vents are not blocked during use.
