INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the My Little Pony Monopoly Board Game! This game allows players to buy, sell, and trade iconic locations throughout Ponyville, including Cutie Mark Clubhouse and Sweet Apple Acres. The objective is to acquire properties, build structures, and collect "Pony Bits" from other players, ultimately driving opponents into bankruptcy.

This edition offers two distinct ways to play: a traditional Monopoly game experience and a faster 60-minute speed play option, catering to different preferences and time availability.

GAME COMPONENTS

The My Little Pony Monopoly game includes the following components:

- **Game Board:** A custom-designed board featuring locations from Ponyville.
- **6 Collectible Pony Tokens:** Unique playing pieces representing Twilight Sparkle, Rainbow Dash, Pinkie Pie, Fluttershy, Rarity, and Applejack.
- **28 Title Deed Cards:** Representing properties available for purchase.
- **16 Mayor Mare Cards:** Replacing traditional Community Chest cards, offering various instructions or rewards.
- **16 Discord's Seeds of Chaos Cards:** Replacing traditional Chance cards, introducing unexpected events.
- **1 Pack of Monopoly Money (Pony Bits):** Custom currency for the game.
- **32 Cottages:** Replacing houses, used to develop properties.
- **12 Castles:** Replacing hotels, used for advanced property development.
- **2 Dice:** Used for movement around the board.
- **Game Rules:** This instruction manual.

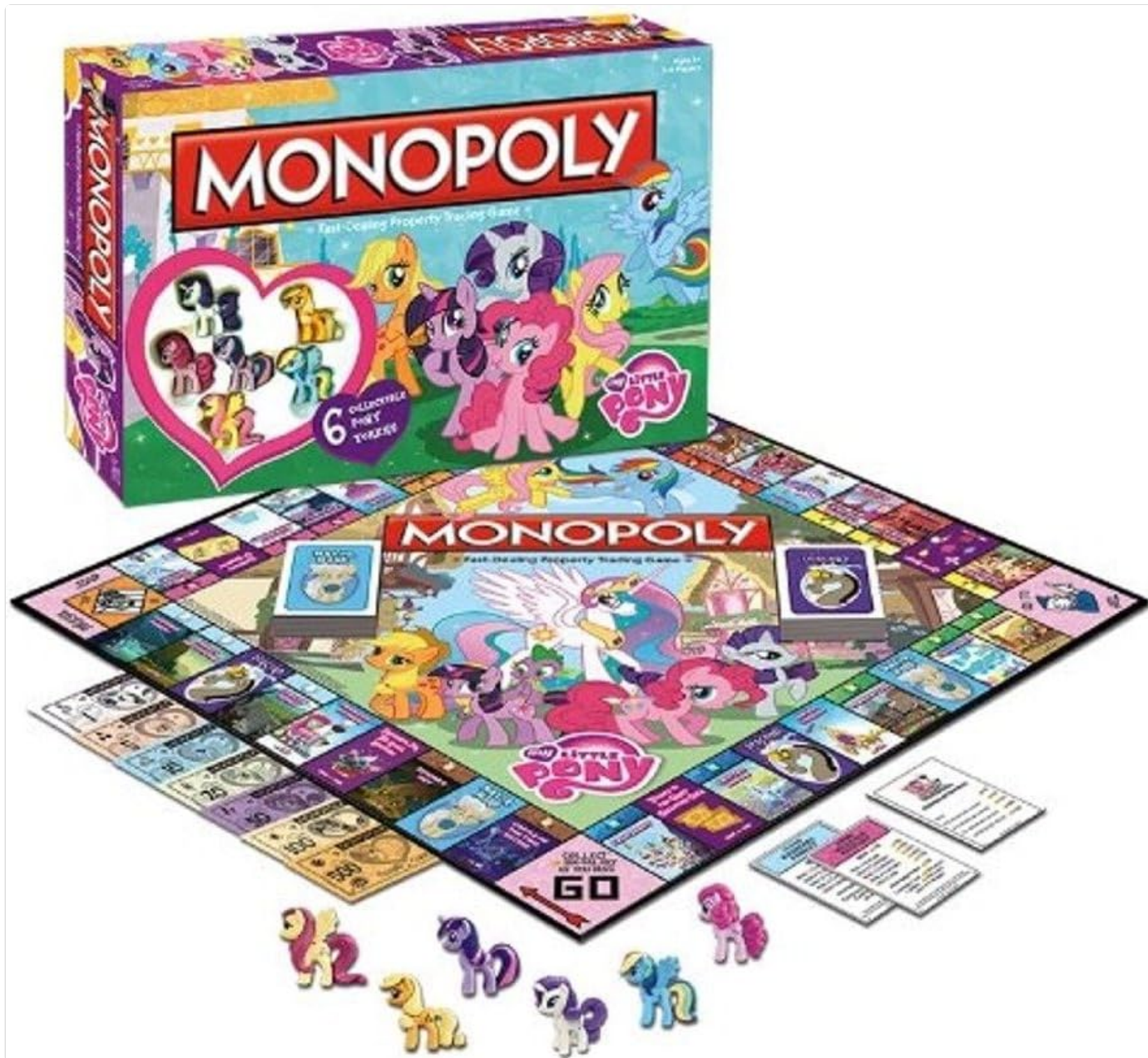


Image: All game components, including the board, money, cards, and the six collectible pony tokens.

SETUP

1. Place the game board on a flat surface.
2. Separate the Mayor Mare cards and Discord's Seeds of Chaos cards. Shuffle each deck and place them face down on their designated spaces on the board.
3. Each player chooses one of the 6 collectible pony tokens to represent them during the game.
4. The Banker (one designated player) distributes the starting "Pony Bits" to each player. Refer to the specific rules for the amount based on the chosen game mode (traditional or speed play).
5. Place the Cottages and Castles near the board, forming a general supply.
6. Place the Title Deed cards next to their corresponding properties on the board, or keep them organized by the Banker.
7. Each player places their chosen pony token on the "GO" space.

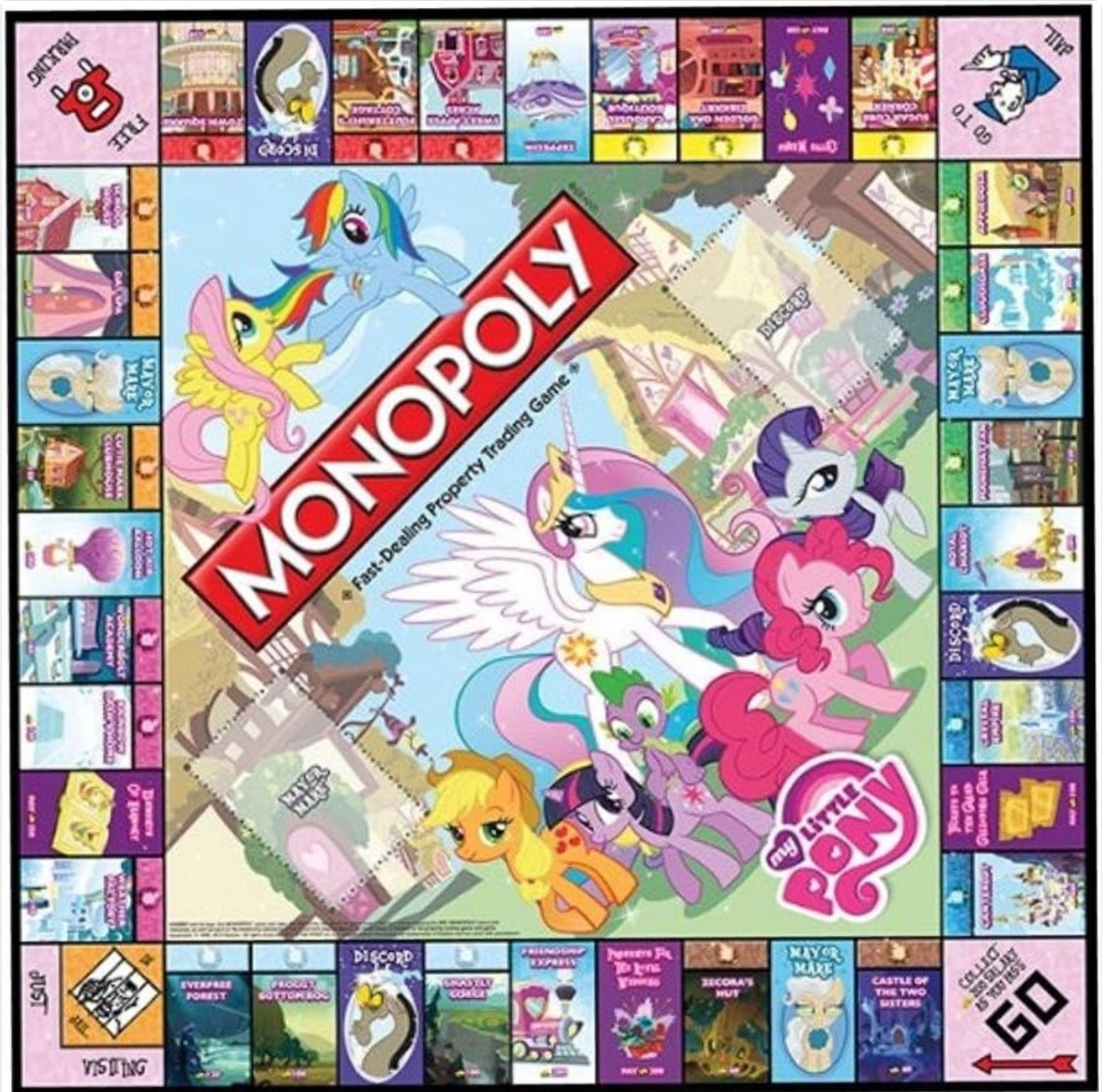


Image: The custom-designed game board featuring Ponyville locations.

OPERATING (GAMEPLAY)

The core gameplay of My Little Pony Monopoly follows the classic Monopoly rules, with themed elements replacing traditional ones. The goal is to be the last player remaining with "Pony Bits" (money) and properties, while all other players have gone bankrupt.

Game Flow:

1. Players roll the dice to determine who goes first (highest roll starts).
2. On a player's turn, they roll both dice and move their pony token clockwise around the board the corresponding number of spaces.
3. The action taken depends on the space landed on:
 - **Unowned Property:** The player may buy the property from the Bank for the price listed on the Title Deed card. If they decline, the property is auctioned to the highest bidder.

- **Owned Property:** The player must pay rent to the owner of the property. The rent amount varies based on whether the property is part of a color set and if Cottages or Castles have been built on it.
 - **Mayor Mare or Discord's Seeds of Chaos:** Draw the top card from the respective deck and follow its instructions.
 - **Go:** Passing or landing on "GO" earns the player a specified amount of "Pony Bits" from the Bank.
 - **Other Spaces:** Includes "Just Visiting" (Jail), "Free Parking," and "Go to Jail." Follow the instructions for each space.
4. Players can buy and sell properties, build Cottages and Castles, and mortgage properties at any time during their turn or between turns.
 5. The game continues until only one player remains solvent.

Special Rules and Theming:

- **Pony Bits:** The game's currency, replacing traditional Monopoly dollars.
- **Cottages and Castles:** These replace houses and hotels for property development.
- **Mayor Mare Cards:** Function as Community Chest cards, often providing unexpected income or expenses.
- **Discord's Seeds of Chaos Cards:** Function as Chance cards, introducing random events that can be beneficial or detrimental.
- **Ponyville Locations:** Properties are named after popular locations throughout Ponyville, such as Canterlot and Crystal Empire.

Two Ways to Play:

- **Traditional Monopoly:** Play according to the standard rules of Monopoly, aiming for long-term strategy and property development.
- **60-Minute Speed Play:** This option introduces modified rules to shorten game duration, making it ideal for quicker sessions. Specific rule adjustments for speed play are detailed in a separate section within the game's included rulebook (if applicable, otherwise follow standard Monopoly speed play variants).

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity of your My Little Pony Monopoly Board Game, please follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Storage:** Always store all game components back in their original box after play. Ensure all cards, money, tokens, and properties are neatly organized to prevent loss or damage.
- **Cleaning:** The game board and components can be gently wiped with a dry, soft cloth if needed. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials, as these may damage the printed surfaces or plastic pieces.
- **Handling:** Handle cards and money with clean, dry hands to prevent wear and tear. Avoid bending or creasing the game board or cards.
- **Environment:** Store the game in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight or extreme temperatures, which can cause warping or fading.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are some common issues and their resolutions:
