Onkyo RC-487S Audio Remote Control Instruction Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your Onkyo RC-487S Audio Remote Control. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the remote control to ensure correct usage and to maximize its lifespan. Keep this manual for future reference.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Onkyo RC-487S is a dedicated audio remote control designed for use with compatible Onkyo audio components. It allows convenient control over various functions such as power, volume, input selection, and playback controls from a distance.

3. SETUP

3.1 Battery Installation

The RC-487S remote control requires two AA (1.5V) alkaline batteries for operation. Batteries are not included with the remote control.

1. Locate the battery compartment cover on the back of the remote control.
2. Slide the battery compartment cover downwards or press the latch and lift to open it.

3. Insert two new AA (1.5V) alkaline batteries, ensuring the positive (+) and negative (-) terminals are aligned correctly according to the diagram inside the compartment.

4. Replace the battery compartment cover by sliding it back into place until it clicks securely.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

To operate your Onkyo audio component using the RC-487S remote control, point the remote directly at the component's infrared sensor. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the component.

- **Power On/Off:** Press the **POWER** button to turn the audio component on or off.
- **Volume Control:** Use the **VOLUME +** and **VOLUME -** buttons to adjust the sound level.
- **Input Selection:** Press the designated input buttons (e.g., CD, DVD, TUNER, AUX) to switch between different audio sources.
- **Playback Controls:** For compatible devices, use buttons such as **PLAY**, **PAUSE**, **STOP**, **SKIP**, and **REWIND/FAST FORWARD** to control media playback.

Refer to your Onkyo audio component's specific instruction manual for detailed functions corresponding to each button on the RC-487S remote control.

5. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and reliable performance of your remote control.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the remote control with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners, waxes, or solvents.
- **Battery Replacement:** Replace both batteries with new ones when the remote control's range decreases or it stops responding. Always replace both batteries at the same time and use the same type (AA alkaline).
- **Storage:** If the remote control will not be used for an extended period, remove the batteries to prevent leakage and potential damage.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you experience issues with your RC-487S remote control, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Solution
Remote control does not work.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Check if the batteries are inserted correctly with the correct polarity.• Replace old batteries with new AA alkaline batteries.• Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote control and the audio component's sensor.• Make sure the remote control is pointed directly at the component's sensor.
Remote control range is reduced.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Replace the batteries.• Ensure the remote control's infrared emitter and the component's sensor are clean and unobstructed.
