1. INTRODUCTION

The Big Boss 16Qt Extra Large Glass Air Fryer is a versatile 4-in-1 countertop appliance designed for frying, baking, grilling, and roasting with minimal oil. It utilizes halogen heat, convection, and infrared technology to cook food efficiently, leaving it moist internally and crispy externally. This appliance features a large 16-quart capacity, allowing for cooking multiple items simultaneously.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Read all instructions before use.
- Do not immerse the top heating unit in water or any liquid.
- Ensure the handle is pressed down to activate the unit.
- Always use oven mitts or the provided tongs when handling hot components.
- Place the appliance on a stable, heat-resistant surface. Allow adequate space around the unit for ventilation.
- Clean the glass bowl and accessories thoroughly before first use.
- Exercise caution when cooking frozen foods, as sudden temperature changes can cause glass to crack. Ensure the glass bowl has cooled before adding cold water for cleaning.
- This appliance operates on 110 volts. Do not use with 220-volt power supplies without an appropriate voltage converter.

3. PRODUCT COMPONENTS

The Big Boss Air Fryer includes several components for versatile cooking:

- **Timer & Temperature Control Lid:** The main heating unit with adjustable temperature and timer dials.
- **Glass Bowl:** The primary cooking chamber, made of durable glass.
- **Bowl Base:** Provides stability for the glass bowl.
- **Extender Ring:** A stainless steel ring to increase cooking capacity for larger items.

- **Mesh Basket:** Ideal for air frying smaller items like fries or onion rings.
- **High Cooking Rack:** For cooking items closer to the heating element.
- **Low Cooking Rack:** For cooking items further from the heating element or for dual-layer cooking.
- **Tray Tongs:** Designed to safely lift hot racks and baskets.

4. SETUP AND FIRST USE

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging.
2. **Clean:** Wash the glass bowl, mesh basket, cooking racks, and extender ring with warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely. Wipe the control lid with a damp cloth.
3. **Assemble:** Place the glass bowl securely into the bowl base. Insert the desired cooking rack(s) or mesh basket. If cooking larger items, place the extender ring on top of the glass bowl before placing the control lid.
4. **Position:** Place the assembled unit on a flat, stable, heat-resistant surface, ensuring adequate clearance from walls

and other appliances.

5. **Power:** Plug the power cord into a standard 110V electrical outlet.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. Basic Operation

1. **Prepare Food:** Place your food on the appropriate rack or in the mesh basket.
2. **Secure Lid:** Place the control lid firmly on top of the glass bowl (or extender ring, if used). Ensure the handle is pressed down to engage the safety switch and allow the unit to power on.
3. **Set Temperature:** Use the top dial to select the desired cooking temperature (ranging from 180°F to 480°F).
4. **Set Timer:** Use the bottom dial to set the cooking time (up to 60 minutes). The unit will begin heating once the timer is set and the handle is down.
5. **Monitor Cooking:** The transparent glass bowl allows you to monitor food progress without opening the unit. The halogen light will turn on and off during operation.

6. **Finish Cooking:** The unit will automatically shut off when the timer reaches zero, indicated by an audible ding. Lift the handle to disengage the power and safely remove the lid.

5.2. Recommended Settings (Approximate)

| Food Item | Temperature | Time |
|--------------|-------------|------------|
| French Fries | 450°F | 20 minutes |
| Onion Rings | 450°F | 15 minutes |
| Fish | 400°F | 18 minutes |
| Chicken | 375°F | 35 minutes |
| Thaw/Wash | 250°F | Variable |

Note: Cooking times and temperatures are approximate and may vary based on food quantity, thickness, and desired crispness. Always ensure food reaches a safe internal temperature.

6. COOKING TIPS

- For best results and even crisping, shake or flip food halfway through the cooking cycle.
- Use the extender ring for larger items like whole chickens or turkeys to ensure proper air circulation.
- Lightly spray food with oil for extra crispiness, especially for fresh vegetables or homemade fries.
- The unit can cook frozen foods without prior thawing, but cooking times may need to be adjusted.
- When cooking multiple items on different racks, consider their individual cooking times and temperatures. Items requiring higher temperatures or longer cooking times may be placed on the top rack.

7. CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

7.1. Cleaning the Glass Bowl and Accessories

- Allow the glass bowl and accessories to cool completely before cleaning.
- The glass bowl, mesh basket, cooking racks, and extender ring are dishwasher safe.
- Alternatively, wash by hand with warm, soapy water and a non-abrasive sponge.
- For stubborn residue, use the "Thaw/Wash" setting with a small amount of water and dish soap in the bowl. Run for a few minutes, then scrub and rinse.
- Ensure all parts are thoroughly dried before reassembly or storage.

7.2. Cleaning the Control Lid

- Wipe the exterior of the control lid with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the lid in water or any other liquid.

- Ensure the lid is completely dry before plugging it back in.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

| Problem | Possible Cause | Solution |
|--------------------------|---|--|
| Unit does not turn on. | Handle not fully lowered; not plugged in; power outage. | Ensure handle is pressed down. Check power cord connection. Verify power supply. |
| Food not cooking evenly. | Overcrowding; food not flipped. | Avoid overcrowding the basket. Flip or shake food halfway through cooking. |
| Food not crispy. | Temperature too low; cooking time too short; too much moisture. | Increase temperature or cooking time. Pat food dry before cooking. Lightly spray with oil. |

| Problem | Possible Cause | Solution |
|--------------------|--|--|
| Glass bowl cracks. | Sudden temperature change (e.g., cold food on hot glass, cold water on hot glass). | Avoid extreme temperature changes. Allow bowl to cool before cleaning with cold water. |
