INTRODUCTION

SAFETY INFORMATION

- Ensure the tool box is securely mounted to prevent shifting during vehicle operation.

- Keep hands and fingers clear of moving parts, such as doors and drawers, to avoid pinching.
- Do not stand or sit on the tool box.
- Regularly inspect the tool box for any signs of wear, damage, or loose fasteners.




Figure 1: Brute 80-HTB88 Tool Box Dimensions. The tool box measures 88 inches in length, 16 inches in height, and 13 inches in depth. It weighs 82 lbs and has a volume of 13.28 cubic feet.

INSTALLATION

The Brute 80-HTB88 Top Sider Tool Box is designed for installation on flat or stake beds. Refer to the included DIY installation instructions for detailed, model-specific mounting procedures. The following are general steps:

- 1. Prepare the Mounting Surface:** Ensure the truck bed rail or stake bed surface is clean, dry, and free of obstructions.
- 2. Position the Tool Box:** Carefully place the tool box on the desired mounting location. Ensure it is level and properly aligned.
- 3. Mark Mounting Points:** Use the tool box's pre-drilled holes as a template to mark the drilling locations on the truck bed.
- 4. Drill Holes:** Drill pilot holes at the marked locations, ensuring not to damage any underlying vehicle components.
- 5. Secure the Tool Box:** Use the provided installation hardware (bolts, washers, nuts) to securely fasten the tool box to the truck bed. Tighten all fasteners evenly.
- 6. Final Check:** Verify that the tool box is firmly attached and does not move or shift. Check that the doors and drawers operate smoothly.

Note: Professional installation is recommended if you are unsure about any steps.

OPERATION

Your Brute Top Sider Tool Box is designed for easy access and secure storage.

Opening and Closing the Flip-Up Doors

- To open, insert the key into the stainless folding locking T-handle and turn to unlock. Pull the handle outwards and lift the door upwards.
- To close, gently lower the door until it rests flush with the box. Push the T-handle inwards and turn the key to lock. Ensure the door is fully latched and locked to prevent accidental opening during transit.

Using the Drawers/Organizers

- The bottom drawers are equipped with organizers for efficient tool storage. Pull the drawer handle to slide the drawer open.
- Push the drawer firmly until it clicks into its closed position to ensure it is secure.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will help preserve the appearance and functionality of your tool box.

- **Cleaning:** Clean the aluminum surface with a mild soap and water solution. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that could damage the finish. Rinse thoroughly and dry with a soft cloth.
- **Lubrication:** Periodically lubricate the door hinges and locking mechanisms with a silicone-based lubricant to ensure smooth operation.

- **Inspection:** Regularly check all fasteners for tightness and re-tighten as necessary. Inspect the weather seals around the doors for any signs of wear or damage that could compromise water resistance.
- **Drainage:** Ensure the overhead rain gutter and any drainage points are clear of debris to maintain water resistance.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Issues and Solutions

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Door difficult to open/close	Lack of lubrication, bent hinge, debris in mechanism	Lubricate hinges and latches. Check for and remove any debris. Inspect hinges for damage.
Water inside the tool box	Damaged or misaligned weather seal, clogged rain gutter	Inspect and replace damaged weather seals. Clear any debris from the rain gutter. Ensure doors are fully closed and latched.
Drawers stick or do not slide smoothly	Debris in drawer slides, bent drawer, overloaded drawer	Clean drawer slides. Ensure drawers are not overloaded. Check for any physical damage to the drawer or slides.
Tool box feels loose on truck bed	Loose mounting hardware	Re-tighten all mounting bolts and fasteners. Inspect mounting points for damage.
