Mothercare VIO 3-Wheeler Stroller User Manual

Model: U1905

1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always ensure your child is securely fastened with the 5-point harness.
- Do not exceed the maximum child weight of **15 kilograms**.
- Never leave your child unattended in the stroller.
- Ensure the stroller is fully open and locked before placing a child inside.
- Keep hands clear of moving parts when folding or unfolding the stroller.
- This stroller is suitable from birth when the seat is in the lie-flat position.
- Regularly check all parts for wear and tear. Discontinue use if any part is damaged.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Mothercare VIO 3-Wheeler Stroller is designed for convenience and comfort. It features a lightweight frame and a compact fold for easy storage and transport. The generously sized seat offers multiple recline positions, including a lie-flat option suitable for newborns. Key features include adjustable height handles, a lockable front swivel wheel for maneuverability, a removable seat liner for easy cleaning, a practical shopping basket, and a hood with a viewing window.

3. SETUP

3.1 Unfolding the Stroller

1. Place the stroller on a flat, stable surface.
2. Locate and release the folding latch, typically found on the side of the frame.
3. Lift the handle upwards firmly until the frame fully extends and clicks into place. Ensure all locking mechanisms are engaged before use.

3.2 Handle Adjustment

1. Locate the handle adjustment buttons on the side of the stroller handle.
2. Press and hold the buttons.
3. Adjust the handle to your desired height.
4. Release the buttons to lock the handle securely in position.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Adjusting Seat Recline

1. To recline the seat, locate the recline mechanism at the back of the seat.
2. Squeeze the lever or press the buttons and gently lower the seat to the desired position.

3. To raise the seat, push it upwards until it locks into place. Ensure it is securely locked before placing a child in the seat.

4.2 Using the 5-Point Harness

1. Place your child in the seat.
2. Bring the shoulder straps over your child's shoulders and connect them to the waist straps.
3. Insert the two buckle clips into the central buckle until they click securely.
4. Adjust the straps for a snug, secure fit.
5. To release, press the button on the central buckle.

4.3 Locking/Unlocking Front Swivel Wheel

1. The front wheel can be locked for stability on uneven terrain or unlocked for greater maneuverability.
2. Locate the lock lever near the front wheel.
3. Push the lever down to lock the wheel in a straight position.
4. Pull the lever up to allow the wheel to swivel freely.

4.4 Folding the Stroller

1. Ensure the seat is in the upright position and the parking brake is engaged.
2. Locate the folding mechanism (refer to your specific model for exact location, typically a lever or buttons on the handle or frame).
3. Follow the specific folding sequence, usually involving pressing a button and pulling a lever simultaneously.
4. Push the handle forward until the stroller folds compactly.
5. Secure the stroller with the folding latch to prevent accidental unfolding.

4.5 Using the Shopping Basket

The shopping basket located under the seat is designed for light items. Do not overload the basket, as this can affect the stroller's stability and maneuverability. Adhere to the maximum weight limit specified for the basket.

4.6 Using the Hood and Weathershield

Extend the hood to provide shade and protection from light elements. Use the viewing window to check on your child without disturbing them. Attach the Mothercare Weathershield over the stroller to protect your child from rain and wind, ensuring it is securely fitted around the frame.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning

- **Wipe clean only.** Use a damp cloth and mild soap for spot cleaning the fabric and frame.
- Do not machine wash or tumble dry any fabric components unless specifically stated on their care labels.
- Allow all components to air dry completely before folding or storing the stroller.

5.2 Removable Seat Liner

The removable seat liner can be taken out for separate cleaning. Follow the specific care instructions provided on the liner's label to ensure its longevity.

5.3 Wheel Care

Regularly check wheels for debris such as dirt, hair, or string, and clean as necessary. If wheels become stiff or squeaky, lubricate moving parts with a silicone-based spray. Avoid using oil-based lubricants as they can attract more dirt.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Stroller difficult to fold/unfold:** Check for any obstructions in the folding mechanism. Ensure the seat is fully upright and the parking brake is engaged before attempting to fold. Refer to the folding instructions carefully.
- **Wheels not turning smoothly:** Clean any dirt or debris from the wheel axles and bearings. Ensure the wheel locks are disengaged if you want them to swivel. Lubricate as per maintenance instructions.
- **Harness not securing:** Ensure all five points of the harness are correctly inserted into the central buckle until they click. Check for any twists or damage to the straps or buckle.
- **Stroller feels unstable:** Ensure the stroller is fully open and all locking mechanisms are engaged. Do not exceed the maximum weight limit.
