### **Initial Connection**

1. Uncoil the 9 ft. professional length power cable.
2. Plug the hair dryer into a suitable electrical outlet. Ensure the voltage matches your local power supply.
3. The hair dryer is now ready for use.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### Power and Temperature Control

The ghd Air Hair Dryer features variable heat and power controls to customize your blow-dry experience. These controls are located on the handle for easy access.

- **Heat Settings:** Use the top switch to select your desired heat level (low, medium, high).
- **Speed Settings:** Use the bottom switch to adjust the airflow speed (low, medium, high).

## Concentrator Nozzle

Attach the concentrator nozzle to the front of the hair dryer to direct airflow for more precise styling, especially when blow-drying specific sections or aiming for a sleek finish.

## Cool Shot Function

Press and hold the cool shot button (often marked with a snowflake icon) to instantly deliver a burst of cool air. This function is ideal for setting your style and locking in shine after blow-drying with heat.

## CARE AND MAINTENANCE

---

### Cleaning the Air Filter

Regularly clean the air filter located at the rear of the hair dryer to maintain optimal performance and prevent overheating. To clean:

1. Ensure the hair dryer is unplugged and completely cool.
2. Twist or pull off the rear filter cover.
3. Gently brush away any dust, lint, or hair accumulation from the filter mesh.
4. Replace the filter cover securely.

## Storage

Store the hair dryer in a cool, dry place. Avoid wrapping the cord tightly around the dryer, as this can damage the cord over time. Use the hanging loop on the handle for convenient storage.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Dryer not turning on	No power supply; faulty outlet or cord.	Check if the dryer is properly plugged in. Test the outlet with another appliance. Inspect the power cord for damage.
Reduced airflow or overheating	Blocked air filter.	Unplug the dryer and allow it to cool. Clean the air filter as described in the Maintenance section.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Hair getting caught in the dryer	Hair too close to the rear air intake.	Ensure hair is kept away from the rear air filter during use. Consider tying back longer sections of hair.
