INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the KitchenAid 7-Speed Hand Mixer. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and care of your new appliance. Please read all instructions carefully before using the mixer for the first time and retain this manual for future reference. The KitchenAid 7-Speed Hand Mixer is designed to provide versatile mixing capabilities for a wide range of culinary tasks, from light whipping to incorporating dense ingredients.

IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed, including the following:

- 1. Read all instructions.
- 2. To protect against risk of electrical shock, do not put the mixer body in water or other liquid.
- 3. Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- 4. Unplug from outlet when not in use, before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning.
- 5. Avoid contact with moving parts. Keep hands, hair, clothing, as well as spatulas and other utensils away from beaters during operation to prevent injury and/or damage to the mixer.
- 6. Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug or after the appliance malfunctions, or is dropped or damaged in any manner. Return appliance to the nearest authorized service facility for examination, repair, or electrical or mechanical adjustment.
- 7. The use of attachments not recommended or sold by KitchenAid may cause fire, electric shock, or injury.
- 8. Do not use outdoors.

- 9. Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter.
- 10. Do not let cord contact hot surfaces, including the stove.
- 11. Remove beaters from mixer before washing.
- 12. This product contains chemicals known to the State of California to cause cancer and birth defects or other reproductive harm.

Components

The KitchenAid 7-Speed Hand Mixer comes with the following components:

- Stainless Steel Turbo Beater II Accessories (2)
- Pro Whisk Attachment

- Lockable Swivel Cord: Allows the cord to be positioned out of the way during mixing for convenience.
- Single-Handed Beater Eject Button: Enables quick and easy removal of accessories.

SETUP

Before First Use

Before using your hand mixer for the first time, wipe the mixer body with a damp cloth. Wash the Turbo Beater II accessories and Pro Whisk in warm, soapy water, then rinse and dry thoroughly. All accessories are dishwasher-safe.

Attaching Accessories

- 1. Ensure the hand mixer is unplugged from the electrical outlet.
- Insert the desired accessories (Turbo Beater II or Pro Whisk) into the openings on the bottom of the mixer. Push firmly until they click into place. The Turbo Beater II accessories are interchangeable and can be inserted into either opening.

Power Connection

Once accessories are securely attached, plug the hand mixer into a standard electrical outlet. The lockable swivel cord can be adjusted to keep it out of your way during operation.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Speed Control

The KitchenAid 7-Speed Hand Mixer features a precise electronic control with 7 speeds. The speed control is located on the top of the mixer. Use the up and down arrows to adjust the speed.

- **Speed 1 (Stir):** For combining dry ingredients, starting batters, or mixing in nuts and chocolate chips.
- Speeds 2-4 (Blend/Mix): For mixing thin batters, gravies, and sauces.
- Speeds 5-6 (Beat): For beating whole eggs, creaming butter and sugar, or mixing medium

batters.

• Speed 7 (Whip): For whipping egg whites, heavy cream, or meringues to fluffy peaks.

Mixing Techniques

- 1. Always start mixing at a low speed to prevent splashing, then gradually increase to the desired speed.
- 2. Move the mixer slowly around the bowl, ensuring all ingredients are incorporated.
- 3. For best results, use a bowl large enough to contain ingredients without overflow.
- 4. When finished mixing, turn the mixer off before lifting it from the bowl.

CARE AND CLEANING

Cleaning the Mixer Body

Always unplug the hand mixer before cleaning. Wipe the mixer body with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the mixer body in water or other liquids. Do not use abrasive cleaners or scouring pads, as they may scratch the surface.

Cleaning Accessories

The Stainless Steel Turbo Beater II accessories and the Pro Whisk attachment are dishwasher-safe. For manual cleaning, wash them in warm, soapy water, then rinse and dry thoroughly.

Storage

Store the hand mixer and its accessories in a clean, dry place when not in use. Ensure the cord is neatly wrapped to prevent damage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If your KitchenAid Hand Mixer experiences issues, consult the following table for common problems and solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Mixer does not turn on.	Not plugged in; power outlet not functioning.	Ensure the mixer is securely plugged into a working electrical outlet. Test the outlet with another appliance.
Beaters are difficult to insert or remove.	Accessories not aligned correctly; eject button not fully pressed.	Ensure accessories are aligned with the openings. Press the eject button firmly to release.
Mixer seems to struggle with thick mixtures.	Speed setting too low; mixture too dense for hand mixer.	Increase the speed setting. For very thick doughs, a stand mixer may be more appropriate.
Unusual noise during operation.	Beaters not fully inserted; internal issue.	Ensure beaters are fully inserted. If noise persists, discontinue use and contact customer support.
