INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Hurom SJ-200B Slow Juicer. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and care of your new juicer. The Hurom SJ-200B is designed to extract maximum nutrition and flavor from fruits, vegetables, and leafy greens through its advanced slow juicing technology. Please read this manual thoroughly before first use and keep it for future reference.

IMPORTANT SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

- Ensure the juicer is connected to a **220V** power supply only. Using an incorrect voltage may damage

the appliance and void the warranty.

- Do not immerse the motor base in water or any other liquid.
- Keep hands and utensils out of the feeding chute during operation to prevent injury. Always use the provided tamper.
- Ensure all parts are correctly assembled before operating the juicer.
- Unplug the juicer from the power outlet before cleaning, assembling, or disassembling.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Do not operate the juicer if the power cord or plug is damaged, or if the appliance malfunctions or has been dropped or damaged in any manner.

PRODUCT COMPONENTS

The Hurom SJ-200B Slow Juicer comes with several key components designed for optimal juicing performance and ease of use. Familiarize yourself with each part before assembly.

- **Motor Base:** The main unit containing the motor.
- **Hopper:** The top part where ingredients are fed.
- **Drum Assembly:** Includes the juicing bowl, auger, fine screen, coarse screen, and spinning brush.
- **Auger:** The spiral screw that crushes and presses ingredients. Manufactured from GE Ultem material for durability.
- **Fine Screen:** For smooth juice with minimal pulp.
- **Coarse Screen:** For juice with more pulp, or for softer fruits.
- **Pulp Extraction Plugs:** Control pulp discharge.
- **Self-Cleaning Screen Holder:** Aids in cleaning the screen.
- **Juice Cups (2):** Two 50 oz cups for collecting juice and pulp.
- **Tamper:** For safely pushing ingredients down the chute.
- **Cleaning Brush:** For thorough cleaning of components.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Follow these steps to assemble your Hurom SJ-200B Slow Juicer before first use.

1. Place the motor base on a stable, flat surface.
2. Align the juicing bowl (drum assembly) with the motor base and rotate it clockwise until it locks into place.
3. Insert the spinning brush into the juicing bowl.
4. Place either the fine or coarse screen inside the spinning brush, ensuring it sits securely.
5. Insert the auger into the center of the screen, pressing down and rotating slightly until it settles firmly.
6. Place the hopper onto the juicing bowl, aligning the red dot on the hopper with the red dot on the juicing bowl, then rotate clockwise until it locks.
7. Position the juice cup under the juice outlet and the pulp cup under the pulp outlet.
8. Ensure the pulp extraction plug is correctly inserted.

9. Plug the power cord into a 220V electrical outlet.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Ingredient Preparation

- Wash all fruits and vegetables thoroughly.
- Remove large seeds, pits, and hard skins (e.g., pineapple, melon, citrus).
- Cut ingredients into pieces that fit easily into the feeding chute. For fibrous vegetables like celery or leafy greens, cut them into shorter lengths (approx. 1-2 inches) to prevent clogging.

2. Juicing Process

1. With the juicer assembled and plugged in, turn the power switch to the "ON" position.
2. Slowly feed prepared ingredients into the feeding chute. Do not force ingredients down; allow the auger to pull them in naturally.
3. Use the tamper only if necessary to gently guide ingredients.
4. Juice will flow from the juice outlet, and pulp will be expelled from the pulp outlet.
5. For continuous juicing, ensure the juice and pulp cups do not overflow.
6. After juicing, turn the power switch to "OFF" and unplug the appliance.

3. Tips for Optimal Juicing

- Alternate between soft and hard ingredients to maintain efficient juicing.
- For leafy greens and wheatgrass, feed them in small batches.
- The dual-stage extraction process ensures maximum yield and dry pulp.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning ensures the longevity and hygienic operation of your Hurom SJ-200B Slow Juicer.

1. Disassembly

1. Ensure the juicer is turned "OFF" and unplugged.
2. Rotate the hopper counter-clockwise to unlock and remove it.
3. Remove the auger, then the screen and spinning brush.
4. Rotate the juicing bowl counter-clockwise to unlock and remove it from the motor base.

2. Cleaning

- **Self-Cleaning Feature:** For quick cleaning between different ingredients, pour a glass of water into the feeding chute while the juicer is running. This helps rinse the internal components.
- **Thorough Cleaning:** Immediately after each use, rinse all detachable parts (hopper, auger, screens, spinning brush, juicing bowl, cups) under running water.
- Use the provided cleaning brush to remove any pulp residue from the screens and other components. Pay special attention to the fine mesh of the screens.
- All detachable parts are recommended for **hand washing only**. Do not wash them in a dishwasher.
- Wipe the motor base with a damp cloth. Never immerse the motor base in water.
- Ensure all parts are completely dry before reassembling or storing.

3. Storage

Store the assembled or disassembled juicer in a clean, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Juicer does not turn on.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Not plugged in.• Parts not assembled correctly.• Power outage.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Check power connection.• Reassemble all parts, ensuring they are locked into place.• Check household circuit breaker.
Motor stops during operation.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Overload protection activated.• Too much pulp buildup.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Turn off, unplug, disassemble, clean, and wait 30 minutes before restarting.• Clean the juicing chamber and screen.
Pulp is wet.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ingredients too soft or watery.• Pulp outlet clogged.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Alternate with harder ingredients.• Clean the pulp outlet.
Excessive vibration or noise.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Parts not assembled correctly.• Hard object in juicing chamber.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Disassemble and reassemble carefully.• Turn off, unplug, and check for foreign objects.
