# Haier HSC-2590EGCB Microwave Oven User Manual

Model: HSC-2590EGCB

## 1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should be followed, including the following:

- Read all instructions before using the appliance.
- Do not operate the oven if it is damaged or malfunctioning. Contact qualified service personnel.
- Do not heat liquids or other foods in sealed containers as they are liable to explode.
- Do not use corrosive chemicals or vapors in this appliance.
- This appliance is intended for household use only.
- Close supervision is necessary when the appliance is used by or near children.
- Do not immerse the power cord, plug, or the appliance in water or other liquid.
- Ensure proper ventilation around the microwave oven.
- Always use microwave-safe cookware.

## 2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Haier HSC-2590EGCB is a 25-liter microwave oven with grill and ventilation functions, designed for efficient cooking and heating.

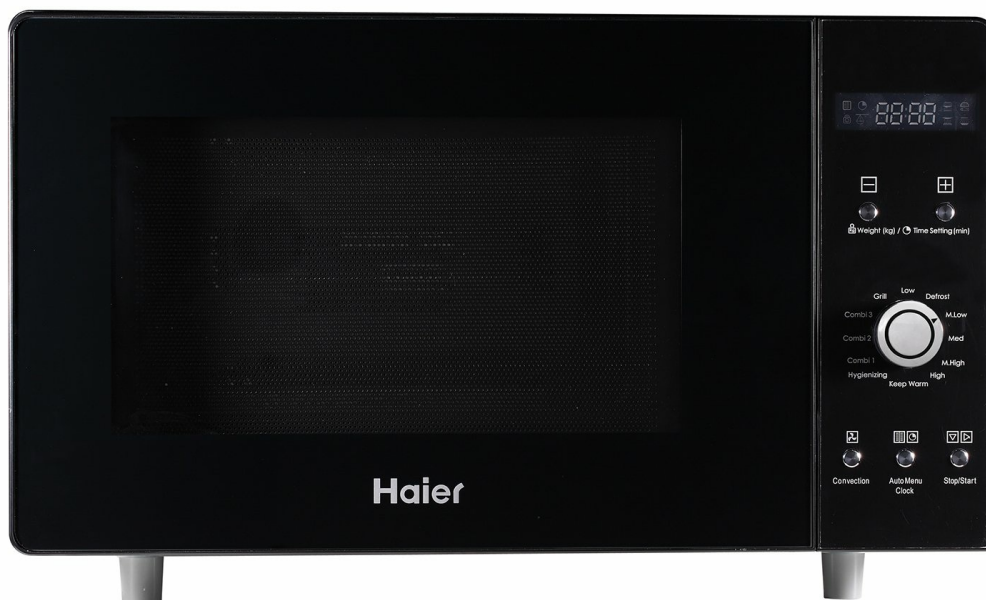

### Components:

- **Door:** Features a safety lock system.
- **Control Panel:** Includes buttons for various functions and a digital display.
- **Turntable:** Rotates food for even cooking.
- **Turntable Support:** Holds the turntable in place.
- **Waveguide Cover:** Protects the microwave components. Do not remove.
- **Grill Heater:** Located at the top interior for grilling functions.

## 3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

---

### 3.1 Unpacking

Carefully remove all packaging materials from the microwave oven and its accessories. Check the oven for any damage, such as dents or a broken door. Do not install if damaged.

### 3.2 Placement

- Place the oven on a flat, stable surface strong enough to hold its weight.
- Ensure adequate ventilation: leave at least 20 cm of space above the oven, 10 cm at the rear, and 5 cm on each side.
- Do not block any ventilation openings.
- Keep the oven away from heat sources and strong magnetic fields.

### 3.3 Electrical Connection

- Plug the power cord into a properly grounded electrical outlet (230V, 50Hz).
- Do not use extension cords or adapters.
- Ensure the voltage specified on the appliance matches your local power supply.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### 4.1 Setting the Clock

1. Press the 'Clock' button once.
2. Use the 'Time/Weight' dial or number buttons to set the hour.
3. Press 'Clock' again.
4. Use the 'Time/Weight' dial or number buttons to set the minutes.
5. Press 'Clock' to confirm.

### 4.2 Microwave Cooking

1. Place food in a microwave-safe container on the turntable.
2. Close the oven door securely.
3. Press the 'Microwave' button.
4. Use the 'Power Level' button to select the desired power (e.g., 100% for high, 50% for medium).
5. Use the 'Time/Weight' dial or number buttons to set the cooking time.
6. Press 'Start' to begin cooking.

### 4.3 Grill Function

1. Place food on the grill rack (if provided) in a heat-resistant dish.
2. Press the 'Grill' button.
3. Use the 'Time/Weight' dial or number buttons to set the grilling time.
4. Press 'Start'.

### 4.4 Defrosting

The oven offers defrosting by weight or by time.

### Defrost by Weight:

1. Place frozen food in the oven.
2. Press the 'Defrost by Weight' button.
3. Use the 'Time/Weight' dial or number buttons to select the food weight.
4. Press 'Start'.

### Defrost by Time:

1. Place frozen food in the oven.
2. Press the 'Defrost by Time' button.
3. Use the 'Time/Weight' dial or number buttons to set the defrosting time.
4. Press 'Start'.

## 4.5 Stopping/Canceling Operation

To pause cooking, open the door or press the 'Stop/Cancel' button once. To cancel a program completely, press 'Stop/Cancel' twice.

## 5. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

---

### 5.1 Cleaning the Oven Interior

- Wipe the interior cavity with a damp cloth after each use.
- For stubborn stains, use a mild detergent or a microwave-safe cleaner.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners or scouring pads.
- Regularly clean the waveguide cover to prevent food residue buildup.

### 5.2 Cleaning the Oven Exterior

- Wipe the exterior surfaces with a soft, damp cloth.
- Clean the control panel gently with a soft, dry cloth.

### 5.3 Cleaning the Turntable and Support

- Remove the turntable and turntable support.
- Wash them in warm, soapy water or in a dishwasher.
- Rinse thoroughly and dry before returning to the oven.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

### Common Issues and Solutions:

- **Oven not starting:** Ensure the power cord is securely plugged in. Check the household fuse or circuit breaker. Make sure the door is closed properly.
- **Food not heating:** Verify that the cooking time and power level are set correctly. Ensure the door is fully closed.
- **Sparks in the oven:** Remove any metal objects or containers. Ensure no food residue is stuck to the interior walls or waveguide cover.
- **Turntable not rotating:** Check if the turntable is correctly placed on its support. Ensure there is no obstruction beneath the turntable.
- **Oven light not working:** The bulb may need replacement. Contact qualified service personnel.

If the problem persists after trying these solutions, contact customer service.
