- **End Cap Cleaning:** Clean any accumulated debris from the brush roll end caps to ensure smooth rotation.
- **Belt Check:** While performing brush roll maintenance, briefly inspect the vacuum belt for tension and condition.

Always unplug the vacuum cleaner before performing any maintenance.

Common Issues and Solutions

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
Brush roll not spinning	Tangled debris, broken belt, motor issue	Unplug vacuum. Remove debris from brush roll. Check/replace belt. If issue persists, consult a service technician.
Reduced cleaning performance	Worn bristles, tangled brush roll, full dustbin/clogged filter	Inspect brush roll for wear and debris. Clean or replace if necessary. Empty dustbin and clean/replace filters.
Unusual noise from brush roll area	Debris caught in brush roll, worn bearings, damaged brush roll	Unplug vacuum. Remove any debris. Inspect brush roll for damage. If noise persists, replacement may be needed.
