INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Divoom Onbeat 200 Bluetooth Portable Speaker. This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, and maintaining your speaker. Please read it thoroughly before use to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your device.

The Divoom Onbeat 200 is a compact and powerful portable speaker designed to deliver rich audio with the convenience of Bluetooth wireless connectivity. It features a built-in microphone for hands-free calling, making it versatile for both music playback and communication.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Divoom Onbeat 200 features a sleek design with intuitive controls. Familiarize yourself with the speaker's components before use.

The speaker is equipped with dual drivers for stereo sound and a passive radiator for enhanced bass. The control panel typically includes power, volume, and Bluetooth pairing buttons. A built-in microphone is integrated for hands-free communication.

SETUP

1. Charging the Speaker

1. Connect the small end of the USB charging cable to the charging port on the speaker.
2. Connect the large end of the USB charging cable to a USB power adapter (not included) or a computer's USB port.
3. The charging indicator light will illuminate, typically red, during charging.
4. Once fully charged, the indicator light will change color or turn off (refer to specific LED behavior in the full manual if available). A full charge usually takes 2-3 hours.

Note: For first-time use, ensure the speaker is fully charged.

2. Bluetooth Pairing

1. Ensure the speaker is charged and turned off.
2. Press and hold the Power button (or dedicated Bluetooth button) for a few seconds until you hear an audible prompt or see the Bluetooth indicator light flashing rapidly, indicating it's in pairing mode.
3. On your smartphone, tablet, or other Bluetooth-enabled device, go to the Bluetooth settings.
4. Enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
5. Select "Onbeat 200" from the list of devices.
6. Once paired, you will hear a confirmation tone, and the Bluetooth indicator light will typically glow solid blue.

Tip: The speaker will automatically attempt to reconnect to the last paired device when powered on, if that device's Bluetooth is active and within range.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Power On/Off

- To power on: Press and hold the Power button until the indicator light illuminates.
- To power off: Press and hold the Power button until the indicator light turns off.

Volume Control

- To increase volume: Press the Volume Up (+) button.
- To decrease volume: Press the Volume Down (-) button.

You can also adjust the volume directly from your connected device.

Music Playback

- Play/Pause: Press the Play/Pause button (often integrated with the Power or Bluetooth button).
- Next Track: Double-press the Volume Up (+) button (or a dedicated skip button).
- Previous Track: Double-press the Volume Down (-) button (or a dedicated skip button).

Note: Specific button functions may vary slightly. Refer to the physical markings on your speaker.

Auxiliary Input (AUX)

For devices without Bluetooth, you can use the 3.5mm audio cable:

1. Connect one end of the 3.5mm audio cable to the AUX-in port on the speaker.
2. Connect the other end to the headphone jack of your audio device.
3. The speaker will automatically switch to AUX mode, or you may need to press a mode button.

MAKING AND RECEIVING CALLS

The Divoom Onbeat 200 features a built-in microphone for hands-free calling when connected via Bluetooth to a smartphone.

- **Answering a Call:** When a call comes in, the music will pause. Press the Play/Pause button (or phone icon button) once to answer the call.
- **Ending a Call:** During a call, press the Play/Pause button (or phone icon button) once to end the call.
- **Rejecting a Call:** Press and hold the Play/Pause button (or phone icon button) for approximately 2 seconds to reject an incoming call.
- **Redialing Last Number:** Double-press the Play/Pause button (or phone icon button) to redial the last number called.

Audio will be routed through the speaker, and your voice will be picked up by the built-in microphone.

MAINTENANCE

- Keep the speaker away from water, moisture, and extreme temperatures.
- Clean the speaker with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Avoid dropping the speaker or subjecting it to strong impacts.
- When not in use for extended periods, store the speaker in a cool, dry place and charge it periodically to maintain battery health.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Solution
Speaker does not power on.	Ensure the speaker is fully charged. Connect it to a power source and try again.
Cannot pair via Bluetooth.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Ensure the speaker is in pairing mode (flashing Bluetooth indicator).◦ Make sure Bluetooth is enabled on your device.◦ Move the speaker closer to your device.◦ Forget "Onbeat 200" from your device's Bluetooth list and try pairing again.◦ Restart both the speaker and your device.
No sound or low volume.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Increase the volume on both the speaker and your connected device.◦ Ensure the speaker is properly paired or the AUX cable is fully inserted.◦ Check if the audio source is playing.
Sound distortion.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Reduce the volume on both the speaker and your connected device.◦ Ensure there are no obstructions between the speaker and your Bluetooth device.◦ Move away from sources of interference (e.g., Wi-Fi routers, other Bluetooth devices).
