# Fagor Oven Control Knob C18T002A6 Instruction Manual

Model: C18T002A6 (Compatible with Fagor HF-113B)

## INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your Fagor Oven Control Knob, part number C18T002A6. This replacement part is designed for compatibility with Fagor oven model HF-113B and other equivalent models. Please read these instructions carefully before proceeding with installation or use to ensure proper function and safety.

## SAFETY INFORMATION

## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to correctly install the replacement control knob:

1. **Disconnect Power:** Before beginning, ensure the oven or cooktop is completely disconnected from

the electrical power supply. This is a critical safety step.

2. **Remove Old Knob:** Gently pull the old control knob directly off its shaft. It should slide off with moderate force. Avoid twisting or prying excessively, as this could damage the shaft.

5. **Install New Knob:** Carefully push the new knob onto the shaft until it is firmly seated. Do not force it if it doesn't slide on easily; re-check the alignment. The knob should sit flush against the control panel without excessive play.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Knob does not fit onto the shaft.	Incorrect alignment or incompatible part.	Ensure the knob's opening is correctly aligned with the shaft's shape. Verify that the part number C18T002A6 is correct for your oven model (e.g., HF-113B).
Knob is loose or wobbly.	Not fully seated or damaged shaft.	Push the knob firmly onto the shaft until it clicks or is fully seated. Inspect the oven's shaft for damage; if damaged, it may require professional repair.
Knob does not turn or engage oven functions.	Internal oven mechanism issue or incorrect installation.	Ensure the knob is fully pushed onto the shaft. If the problem persists, the issue may be with the oven's internal control mechanism, requiring professional service.
