INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the safe and efficient operation of your CUCKOO Micom Rice Cooker, model CR-0631F. Please read all instructions carefully before use and retain this manual for future reference.

IMPORTANT SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

- Read all instructions before operating the appliance.
- Do not touch hot surfaces. Use handles or knobs.
- To protect against electrical shock, do not immerse cord, plugs, or the appliance in water or other liquid.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- The use of accessory attachments not recommended by the appliance manufacturer may cause injuries.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Extreme caution must be used when moving an appliance containing hot oil or other hot liquids.
- Always attach plug to appliance first, then plug cord into the wall outlet. To disconnect, turn any control to "off", then remove plug from wall outlet.
- Do not use appliance for other than intended use.

PRODUCT COMPONENTS

Your CUCKOO Micom Rice Cooker CR-0631F includes the following components:

- **Main Unit:** The primary rice cooker body with control panel.
- **Inner Pot:** Non-stick cooking pot with measurement markings.
- **Inner Lid:** Detachable lid for easy cleaning.
- **Rice Spatula:** For serving cooked rice.
- **Measuring Cup:** For accurate rice and water measurements.
- **Instruction Manual:** This document.

SETUP AND FIRST USE

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all packaging materials and accessories.
2. **Clean:** Wash the inner pot, inner lid, rice spatula, and measuring cup with warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry. Wipe the exterior of the main unit with a damp cloth.
3. **Assemble:** Place the clean inner pot into the main unit. Ensure the detachable inner lid is securely attached to the main lid.
4. **Placement:** Position the rice cooker on a stable, flat, heat-resistant surface away from direct heat sources or water.
5. **Power Connection:** Plug the power cord into a grounded electrical outlet.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Basic Rice Cooking (White Rice)

1. **Measure Rice:** Use the provided measuring cup to measure the desired amount of rice.
2. **Wash Rice:** Rinse the rice thoroughly under cold water until the water runs clear.
3. **Add Water:** Place the washed rice into the inner pot. Add water up to the corresponding water level mark for "WHITE" rice.
4. **Close Lid:** Close the lid securely until it clicks.
5. **Select Mode:** Press the "Menu" button to select "WHITE" (Glutinous) rice mode.
6. **Start Cooking:** Press the "Cook" button. The cooker will automatically begin the cooking process.
7. **Keep Warm:** Once cooking is complete, the cooker will automatically switch to "Keep Warm" mode.

Specialized Cooking Modes

The CR-0631F offers 7 versatile menu options:

- **White (Glutinous) Rice:** Standard setting for white rice.
- **GABA Rice:** Optimized for GABA (germinated brown rice).
- **Mixed/Brown Rice:** For cooking mixed grains or brown rice.
- **Porridge:** Ideal for preparing various types of porridge.
- **Slow Cook:** For slow-cooking dishes.
- **Turbo Mode:** Cooks fresh white rice in under 35 minutes.
- **My Mode Function:** Allows customization of rice texture and flavor. Refer to the detailed manual for specific adjustments.

Using the Delay Timer

To set a delayed cooking start time:

1. Prepare rice and water in the inner pot as usual.
2. Select the desired cooking mode (e.g., White Rice).
3. Press the "Timer" button. Use the "Hrs" and "Min" buttons to adjust the desired completion time.
4. Press the "Cook" button to confirm. The timer indicator will light up, and cooking will start automatically at the set time.

Keep Warm and Reheat Functions

- **Keep Warm:** The cooker automatically enters "Keep Warm" mode after cooking. This maintains the rice at an optimal serving temperature.
- **Reheat:** If rice has cooled, press the "Keep Warm/Reheat" button to reheat it.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and longevity of your rice cooker.

1. **Unplug:** Always unplug the rice cooker from the power outlet before cleaning.
2. **Cool Down:** Allow the appliance to cool completely before disassembling or cleaning.
3. **Inner Pot:** Wash the non-stick inner pot with warm, soapy water using a soft sponge. Avoid abrasive cleaners or scouring pads to prevent damage to the non-stick coating. Rinse thoroughly and dry.
4. **Inner Lid:** Detach the inner lid from the main lid. Wash it with warm, soapy water and a soft sponge. Rinse and dry completely before reattaching.
5. **Main Unit Exterior:** Wipe the exterior of the rice cooker with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the main unit in water.
6. **Steam Vent:** Ensure the steam vent is clear of any food debris.
7. **Water Tray:** Empty and clean the excess water tray regularly.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Rice is too hard/undercooked.	Insufficient water; rice not soaked (for some types).	Add more water next time; ensure proper water-to-rice ratio; soak rice if recommended for the type.
Rice is too soft/mushy.	Too much water.	Reduce water next time; ensure proper water-to-rice ratio.
Rice sticks to the bottom.	Inner pot coating damaged; not enough water.	Ensure inner pot is not scratched; use proper water amount.
"Keep Warm" function not working.	Power issue; function not activated.	Check power connection; ensure "Keep Warm" is selected or activated automatically.
Display shows error code.	Internal malfunction.	Refer to the full manual for specific error codes or contact customer support.


