# VonHaus 16x Interlocking Black Shoe Storage Organizer

## INTRODUCTION

---

This manual provides detailed instructions for the assembly, operation, and maintenance of your VonHaus 16x Interlocking Black Shoe Storage Organizer. This modular system allows for flexible configuration to suit various storage needs and spaces. Please read these instructions carefully before assembly and retain them for future reference.

## SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

---

### Components List:

- Square Panels (typically 16 for the main cubes, plus additional for sides/back)
- Interlocking Connectors (circular pieces)

Ensure all components are present before beginning assembly. If any parts are missing or damaged, please contact customer support.

### **Assembly Steps:**

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all panels and connectors from the packaging.
2. **Identify Parts:** Separate the square panels from the circular connectors.
3. **Assemble a Single Cube:**
  - Take four square panels and four connectors.
  - Insert the corners of two panels into the slots of a connector to form a right angle.
  - Continue adding panels and connectors to form a complete cube. Ensure each panel corner is fully seated into the connector for stability. You may need to apply firm pressure.

4. **Expand the Structure:** Once a cube is formed, attach additional panels and connectors to build more cubes. You can arrange them side-by-side, stacked vertically, or in other configurations to create your desired storage unit.
5. **Ensure Stability:** After completing your desired configuration, gently push on each panel and connector to ensure they are all securely fastened. A sturdy assembly is critical for the unit's stability.

## OPERATION AND USAGE

The VonHaus Interlocking Shoe Storage Organizer is designed for versatile use. Each cube can typically hold one pair of men's shoes or two pairs of women's shoes, depending on shoe size and style. Boots can be stored by removing a panel to create a taller compartment.

- **Shoe Placement:** Place shoes neatly within each cube. For larger shoes or boots, consider removing a horizontal panel to create a double-height space.
- **Configuration Flexibility:** The modular design allows you to reconfigure the unit at any time. Simply disassemble the relevant sections and reassemble them into a new shape or size.
- **Weight Distribution:** Distribute weight evenly across the unit to maintain stability. Avoid placing excessively heavy items in a single cube or on the top of the unit.

## MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and appearance of your shoe organizer, follow these simple maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the panels and connectors with a dry cloth to remove dust and dirt. For stubborn marks, a slightly damp cloth can be used, followed by immediate drying.
- **Avoid Harsh Chemicals:** Do not use abrasive cleaners, solvents, or harsh chemicals, as these can damage the finish of the panels.
- **Regular Checks:** Periodically check all connectors to ensure they remain securely fastened. Re-seat any loose connections to maintain the unit's stability.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Unit feels unstable or wobbly.	Connectors not fully seated; uneven weight distribution.	Ensure all panel corners are pushed firmly into the connectors. Redistribute items to balance weight.
Difficulty connecting panels.	Insufficient force applied; panels misaligned.	Apply firm, even pressure until a click is heard or felt. Ensure panels are aligned correctly with connector slots.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Panels appear warped or damaged.	Improper handling; excessive weight.	Avoid bending panels during assembly. Do not exceed the recommended weight capacity per cube. Contact support for replacement parts if necessary.
