## 1. Important Safety Information

- If you are unsure about any part of the installation, consult a qualified plumber.



# 4. Setup and Installation

This section provides general guidelines for installing your Franke Old England kitchen faucet. Specific installation steps may vary based on your sink and countertop configuration.

- 1. **Prepare the Mounting Area:** Ensure the mounting surface is clean and dry. The required mounting hole diameter is 35 mm.
- 2. **Install the Faucet:** Insert the faucet base into the mounting hole. From underneath the sink, secure the faucet using the provided mounting hardware (washer and nut). Tighten securely but do not overtighten.
- 3. **Connect Water Supply:** Attach the 400 mm long flexible connection hoses to your hot and cold water supply lines. Ensure all connections are hand-tightened, then use a wrench for a final quarter-turn. Do not overtighten.
- 4. **Check for Leaks:** Slowly turn on the main water supply. Check all connections for leaks. If leaks are present, gently tighten the connections until they stop.
- 5. **Flush the System:** Once installed, remove the aerator from the spout and turn on both hot and cold water for a few minutes to flush out any debris from the water lines. Reinstall the aerator.

# 5. Operating Instructions

The Franke Old England kitchen faucet features a single lever for controlling water flow and temperature, and a fixed spout that swivels.

- Water Flow: Lift the lever handle to increase water flow. Push it down to decrease or stop the flow.
- Water Temperature: Move the lever handle to the left for hot water and to the right for cold water. Adjust the position between left and right to achieve the desired temperature.
- **Spout Rotation:** The faucet spout can be rotated up to 360 degrees to direct water flow as needed within your sink area.

## 6. Maintenance

Regular cleaning and maintenance will help preserve the appearance and functionality of your faucet.

- Cleaning the Finish: Clean the copper finish regularly with a soft cloth and mild soap and water. Avoid abrasive cleaners, harsh chemicals, or scouring pads, as these can damage the finish.
- **Aerator Maintenance:** If water flow becomes restricted, the aerator may be clogged. Unscrew the aerator from the end of the spout, clean any debris, and rinse thoroughly before reattaching.
- Cartridge Care: The 40 mm ceramic cartridge is designed for durability. If you experience persistent drips or leaks from the handle, the cartridge may need to be replaced. Consult a professional for cartridge replacement.

## 7. Troubleshooting

Refer to the following table for common issues and their solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Low Water Flow	Clogged aerator; partially closed shut- off valve; kinked supply line.	Clean aerator; ensure shut-off valves are fully open; check supply lines for kinks.
Faucet Leaks from Spout	Worn cartridge; debris in cartridge.	Replace or clean the ceramic cartridge.
Leaks from Base of Faucet	Loose mounting nut; improper seal.	Tighten mounting nut; ensure proper sealing during installation.
Difficulty Adjusting Temperature	Cartridge issue; unbalanced water pressure.	Inspect or replace cartridge; check water pressure to hot and cold lines.


