INTRODUCTION

SETUP

Inserting a Game Cartridge

- The joystick controls character movement or cursor navigation.
- The red button on the joystick is typically used for actions such as firing, jumping, or selecting.

Game Variations and Difficulty Switches

Many Atari 2600 games offer variations or difficulty settings controlled by switches on the console (e.g., "Game Select," "Game Reset," "Difficulty A/B"). Experiment with these switches to explore different game modes and challenges.

MAINTENANCE

Cartridge Care

To ensure the longevity and proper function of your Atari 2600 game cartridges:

- **Cleaning Contacts:** If a game is not working, gently clean the gold-plated contacts on the bottom of the cartridge with a cotton swab lightly dampened with isopropyl alcohol. Allow to dry completely before re-inserting.
- **Storage:** Store cartridges in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and dust. Original dust covers or protective cases are recommended.
- **Handling:** Always handle cartridges by their plastic casing. Avoid touching the metal contacts directly.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Solution
Game does not load or screen is garbled.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure the cartridge is fully seated in the console. • Power off the console, remove the cartridge, gently blow into the cartridge slot (or use compressed air), and re-insert. • Clean the cartridge contacts as described in the Maintenance section. • Try pressing the "Reset" button on the console. • Ensure your TV is on the correct input/channel.
Controller not responding.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Check if the joystick is securely plugged into the console. • Try a different joystick if available.
No sound.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Check your TV's volume and mute settings. • Ensure all audio cables from the console to the TV are securely connected.
