4. Product Overview

Familiarize yourself with the different parts and buttons of your TECKNET mouse:

1. **Left Button:** Standard left-click function.
2. **Right Button:** Standard right-click function.
3. **Scroll Wheel:** For vertical scrolling and middle-click function.

4. **DPI Switch Button:** Adjusts the mouse's sensitivity (DPI).
5. **Low Battery Indicator:** Illuminates to indicate low battery power.
6. **Backward Button:** Navigates back in web browsers or file explorers.
7. **Forward Button:** Navigates forward in web browsers or file explorers.

- **Optical Sensor:** Provides precise tracking on various surfaces.
- **Battery Compartment:** Holds two AA batteries.
- **Bluetooth Pairing Button:** Used to initiate Bluetooth pairing mode.
- **On/Off Switch:** Powers the mouse on or off to conserve battery.

5. Setup

5.1. Battery Installation

The mouse requires two AA batteries (not included).

1. Open the battery compartment cover on the underside of the mouse.
2. Insert two AA batteries, ensuring correct polarity (+/-).

3. Close the battery compartment cover securely.
4. Turn on the mouse using the On/Off switch located on the underside.

5.2. Bluetooth Pairing

To connect your TECKNET mouse via Bluetooth:

1. Ensure the mouse is powered on.
2. Press and hold the Bluetooth pairing button on the underside of the mouse for 3-5 seconds until the blue LED indicator on top of the mouse starts blinking rapidly. This indicates the mouse is in pairing mode.
3. On your computer or device, enable Bluetooth and search for new devices.
4. Select "TECKNET Mouse" or a similar name from the list of available devices.
5. Follow any on-screen prompts to complete the pairing process. The LED indicator on the mouse will stop blinking and remain solid blue once successfully paired.

6. Operating Instructions

6.1. DPI Adjustment

The mouse features 6 adjustable DPI levels, allowing you to customize cursor sensitivity for different tasks. Press the DPI Switch Button (located behind the scroll wheel) to cycle through the following settings:

- 800 DPI
- 1200 DPI
- 1600 DPI
- 2000 DPI
- 2400 DPI
- 3200 DPI

6.2. TruWave Tracking Technology

The TECKNET mouse incorporates TruWave tracking technology, providing precise and intelligent cursor control on a wide variety of surfaces. This allows for consistent performance whether you are on a desk, a fabric surface, or other common materials.

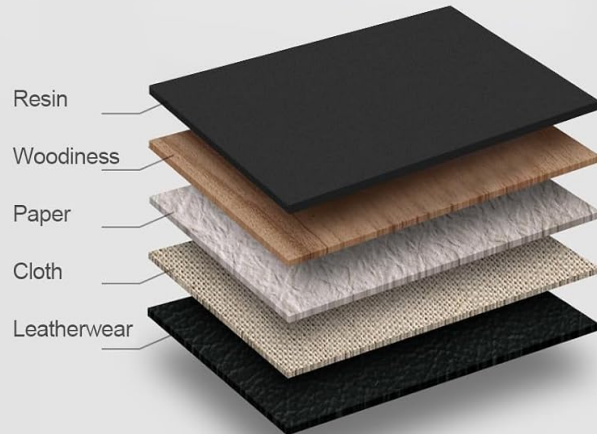

6.3. Smart Sleep Technology

To conserve battery life, the mouse features Smart Sleep technology. If the mouse is inactive for a period, it will automatically enter a low-power sleep mode. To wake the mouse, simply move it or click any button.

6.4. Durability

The mouse is designed for long-lasting usage, having undergone a 10 million times click test to ensure reliability and durability of its buttons.

7. Maintenance

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the mouse. For stubborn dirt, slightly dampen the cloth with water. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Battery Replacement:** When the low battery indicator illuminates, replace the two AA batteries promptly to ensure uninterrupted operation.

8. Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Mouse not connecting/pairing	Low battery; Bluetooth off on device; Mouse not in pairing mode; Interference.	Replace batteries; Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your device; Press and hold pairing button on mouse; Move closer to device; Restart device.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Cursor erratic or unresponsive	Dirty optical sensor; Unsuitable surface; Low battery.	Clean optical sensor with a soft cloth; Use on a clean, non-reflective surface or mouse pad; Replace batteries.
Short battery life	Frequent usage; Old batteries; Mouse not turned off when not in use.	Use high-quality alkaline batteries; Turn off mouse when not in use for extended periods.
