1. Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the Universal Charging Station A. - · Do not block any ventilation openings.

4. SETUP GUIDE

Follow these steps to set up your Universal Charging Station A:

1. Unpack the Charging Station: Carefully remove the charging station and its power adapter from the packaging.

6. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- Cleaning: Disconnect the power adapter before cleaning. Use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to wipe the surface of the charging station. Do not use abrasive cleaners, waxes, or solvents.
- **Contacts:** Periodically inspect the charging contacts on the station and your handset for dust or debris. Clean them gently with a dry cotton swab if necessary.
- Storage: If storing the charging station for an extended period, unplug it from the power outlet and store it in a cool, dry place.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your charging station, refer to the following table for common problems and solutions.

| Problem | Possible Cause | Solution |
|-----------------------|--|--|
| Handset not charging. | Power adapter not connected. Power outlet is not active. Handset not properly seated. Dirty charging contacts. Incompatible handset. | Ensure power adapter is securely plugged into the station and wall outlet. Test the outlet with another device. Reseat the handset, ensuring contacts align. Clean charging contacts on both station and handset. Verify your handset model is listed as compatible. |
| Charging is slow. | Using a non-original power adapter. Handset battery degradation. | Ensure you are using the original power adapter. Consider replacing the handset battery if it's old. |
| Station feels warm. | Normal operation during charging. Poor ventilation. | Slight warmth is normal. Ensure the station is in a well-ventilated area. If it becomes excessively hot, unplug it immediately and contact support. |
