The Frigidaire 316489400 Bake Igniter is a genuine OEM (Original Equipment Manufacturer) part designed to ignite the bake burner in gas-fueled ovens on ranges. This igniter replaces several part numbers, including 1197384, 316428500, 316428501, 5304462661, 7316489400, AH1528534, EA1528534, and PS1528534.

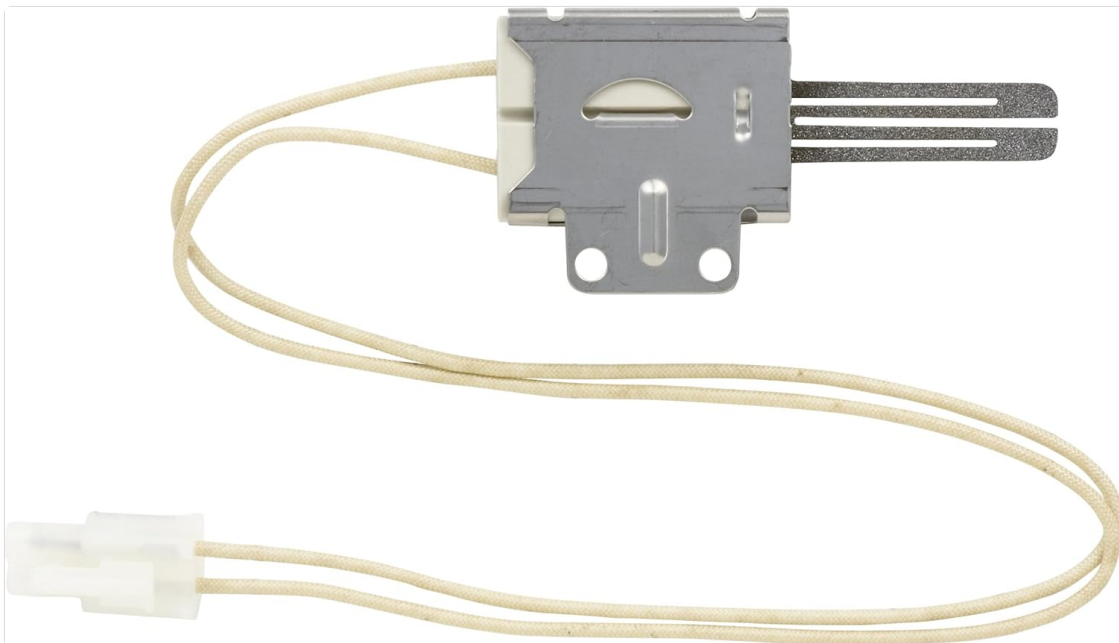


Image 1: Frigidaire 316489400 Bake Igniter, showing the ceramic igniter element and wiring.

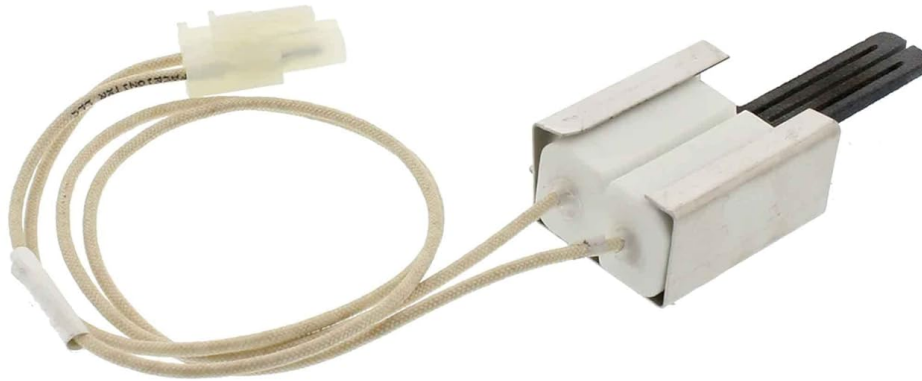

4. INSTALLATION AND SETUP

Replacing a bake igniter requires careful handling due to its fragile nature. The component is sensitive to contamination and physical shock. Follow these general steps, but always refer to your specific appliance's service manual for detailed instructions.

General Installation Steps:

1. **Disconnect Power and Gas:** Turn off the electrical power to the range at the circuit breaker and shut off the gas supply valve.
2. **Access the Oven Cavity:** Open the oven door and remove the oven racks. Depending on your model, you may need to remove the bottom oven panel and/or the flame spreader to access the igniter.
3. **Locate the Igniter:** The bake igniter is typically located near the gas burner tube at the bottom of the oven.
4. **Disconnect Wiring:** Carefully disconnect the electrical connector from the old igniter. Avoid touching the ceramic part of the igniter as oils from your skin can shorten its lifespan.
5. **Remove Old Igniter:** Unscrew the mounting screws that secure the igniter to the burner tube or oven floor.
6. **Install New Igniter:** Attach the new Frigidaire 316489400 igniter using the original mounting screws.

7. **Connect Wiring:** Connect the new igniter's electrical connector. Ensure a secure connection.
8. **Reassemble:** Replace the flame spreader and bottom oven panel, then the oven racks.
9. **Restore Utilities:** Turn the gas supply back on and restore electrical power to the range.
10. **Test Operation:** Set the oven to bake at a moderate temperature and observe if the igniter glows and the burner ignites properly.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The bake igniter operates automatically when the oven is set to a bake temperature. It is designed to glow and heat sufficiently to open the gas valve and ignite the gas flowing to the burner.

- Upon selecting a bake function and temperature, the igniter will begin to heat.
- Once the igniter reaches a sufficient temperature (typically 1800°F - 3100°F), it will allow the gas valve to open.
- The gas will then flow over the hot igniter, causing it to ignite and produce a flame.
- The igniter will continue to glow during the bake cycle to maintain the flame.

6. MAINTENANCE

The Frigidaire 316489400 Bake Igniter is a sealed unit and does not require routine maintenance. However, proper care of your oven can help prolong the life of all its components, including the igniter.

- Keep the oven cavity clean to prevent grease and food debris from accumulating near the igniter or burner.
- Avoid harsh chemical cleaners directly on the igniter or burner components.
- Regularly inspect the igniter for any visible signs of damage or excessive wear.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If your oven is experiencing issues related to heating or ignition, the bake igniter may be a contributing factor. Here are common symptoms and potential causes:

| Symptom | Possible Cause |

| Oven not heating or taking a long time to heat | Weak or failing igniter that is not drawing enough current to open the gas valve fully or quickly. |
| Oven not lighting (no flame) | Igniter is burned out or broken, preventing it from heating sufficiently to ignite gas. |

| Symptom | Possible Cause |
|--------------------------------------|--|
| Unpleasant gas smell when oven is on | Igniter is weak, allowing gas to escape before ignition, or the gas valve is not closing properly. |
| Oven igniter glows but no flame | Igniter is not reaching sufficient temperature to open the gas valve, or the gas valve itself is faulty. |

If you encounter these issues, consider inspecting the igniter for visible damage or testing its resistance/current draw if you have the appropriate tools and expertise. Always ensure safety precautions are followed.

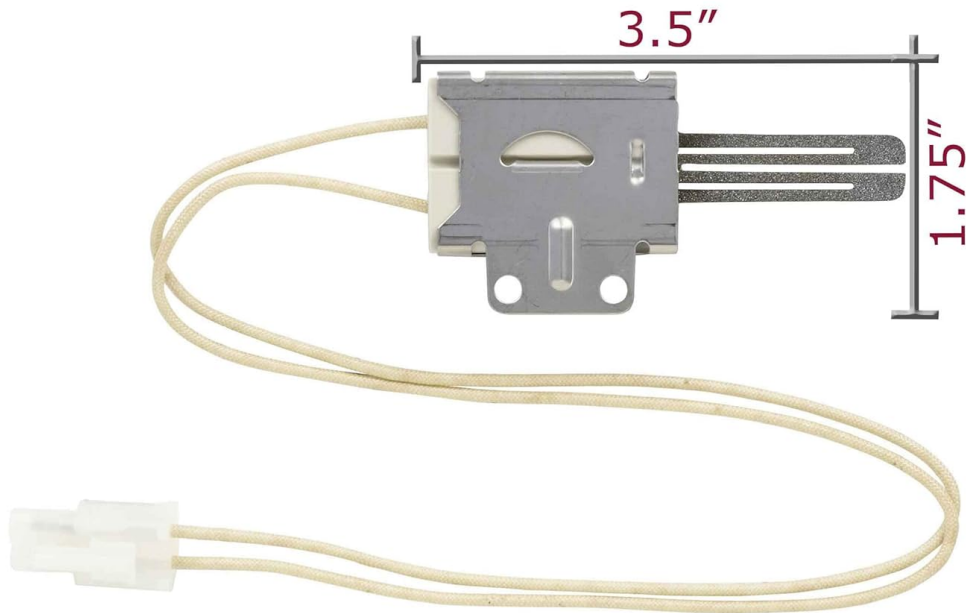
