- **Ignition Cycle:** Programming often involves a specific sequence of turning the vehicle's ignition on and off.
- Button Press Sequence: A series of presses on the remote's button and/or the system's Valet button will be required to enter programming mode and register the new remote.
- **Professional Assistance:** If you encounter difficulties or prefer professional installation, it is recommended to contact an authorized Directed Electronics or Avital dealer/installer. They possess the necessary tools and expertise for proper system integration.

# **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

The 7111L is a 1-button remote control. Its primary function is to arm/disarm your security system or activate your remote start feature, depending on how your Avital system is configured and programmed.

- **Single Press:** Typically, a single press of the button will activate the primary function (e.g., arm/lock or remote start).
- **Press and Hold:** Holding the button for a few seconds may activate a secondary function (e.g., remote start if a single press is for arming, or panic mode).
- Green LED: Observe the green LED on the remote. It will illuminate to indicate that a signal is being transmitted.

Refer to your specific Avital system's user manual for detailed information on how the 1-button remote interacts with its various features.

# MAINTENANCE

- Battery Replacement: The remote requires 1 Lithium Metal battery. When the remote's range
  decreases significantly or the LED indicator becomes dim, it is time to replace the battery. Open the
  remote casing carefully, replace the old battery with a new one of the same type, ensuring correct
  polarity.
- Cleaning: Clean the remote with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.

- Storage: Store the remote in a dry place, away from extreme temperatures and direct sunlight.
- Avoid Damage: Protect the remote from drops, impacts, and exposure to water or excessive moisture.

### **TROUBLESHOOTING**

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Remote not responding	Dead or low battery	Replace the Lithium Metal battery.
Remote not responding	Remote is not programmed to the system	Follow the programming instructions included with the remote or consult a professional installer.
Reduced operating range	Low battery	Replace the Lithium Metal battery.
Reduced operating range	Environmental interference	Move closer to the vehicle or away from sources of electronic interference.
Green LED does not light up	Dead battery	Replace the Lithium Metal battery.
