INTRODUCTION

The Master Lock No. 4120KA 213 Economy Padlock is designed for general security applications, featuring a durable brass body and a hardened steel shackle. This padlock is part of the Keyed Alike series, meaning multiple locks can be opened with the same key, offering convenience for users with several locking points. Its construction is engineered to resist environmental elements and cutting attempts, making it suitable for various indoor and outdoor uses.

Key features include:

- Brass Body: Provides resistance against corrosion and weathering.
- Hardened Steel Shackle: Offers enhanced resistance to cutting and sawing.
- 3-Pin Tumbler Cylinder: Designed for greater pick resistance.
- Keyed Alike: Simplifies key management by allowing one key to open multiple compatible locks.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The Master Lock V Line padlock is designed for straightforward use. No complex installation is required. Simply identify the item or area you wish to secure.

- 1. **Identify Application:** Determine where the padlock will be used, such as on a cabinet, fence, locker, or luggage.
- 2. Insert Key: Insert one of the provided keys into the keyway at the bottom of the padlock.
- 3. Turn Key: Turn the key clockwise to unlock the shackle. The shackle will spring open.
- 4. Position Shackle: Place the open shackle around the items or through the hasp you intend to secure.
- 5. Close Shackle: Press the shackle firmly back into the padlock body until it clicks shut.
- 6. Remove Key: Turn the key counter-clockwise and remove it. The padlock is now secured.



OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Operating your Master Lock padlock is simple and intuitive.

To Lock:

- Ensure the shackle is positioned through the item(s) to be secured.
- Push the shackle down into the padlock body until you hear a distinct click. This indicates the shackle is locked.
- Gently pull on the shackle to confirm it is securely locked before leaving.

To Unlock:

• Insert the correct key into the keyway.

- Turn the key clockwise until the shackle springs open.
- Remove the shackle from the secured item(s).
- Turn the key counter-clockwise and remove it from the keyway.

MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance will extend the life and functionality of your Master Lock padlock.

- Cleaning: Periodically wipe the padlock body and shackle with a clean, dry cloth to remove dirt and grime. For brass components, a mild brass cleaner can be used if desired, but avoid harsh abrasives.
- Lubrication: If the key becomes difficult to turn or the shackle sticks, apply a small amount of graphite lubricant or a silicone-based spray lubricant into the keyway and around the shackle entry points. Avoid oil-based lubricants as they can attract dirt.
- Storage: When not in use, store the padlock in a dry environment to prevent excessive exposure to moisture, which can lead to corrosion over time, especially in humid conditions.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Master Lock padlock, consider the following common solutions:

Key is Difficult to Turn or Won't Turn:

- Wrong Key: Ensure you are using the correct key for this specific padlock. Although it is "Keyed Alike" with others of the same series, it will not open with a different key type.
- **Debris in Keyway:** Inspect the keyway for any foreign objects, dirt, or debris. Use compressed air or a small, non-metallic pick to gently clear any obstructions.
- Lack of Lubrication: Apply a small amount of graphite or silicone-based lubricant into the keyway and try turning the key again.

Shackle is Stuck or Won't Open/Close:

- **Corrosion:** If the padlock has been exposed to moisture, corrosion might be present. Apply a penetrating lubricant to the shackle entry points and work the shackle back and forth.
- Misalignment: Ensure the shackle is properly aligned with the holes in the padlock body when attempting to close it.
- Damage: Inspect the shackle and padlock body for any visible damage or deformation that might prevent proper operation.


