Symptom	Possible Cause	Solution
Clunking or popping noise from suspension/steering	Worn or loose ball joint, improper installation	Inspect ball joint for play. Re-torque fasteners. Replace if worn.
Excessive play in steering wheel	Worn ball joint, other steering/suspension components	Inspect all steering and suspension components, including the ball joint. Replace faulty parts.
Uneven tire wear	Misalignment, worn suspension components (including ball joint)	Check for worn components. Perform a wheel alignment.

If troubleshooting steps do not resolve the issue, consult a professional automotive technician.
