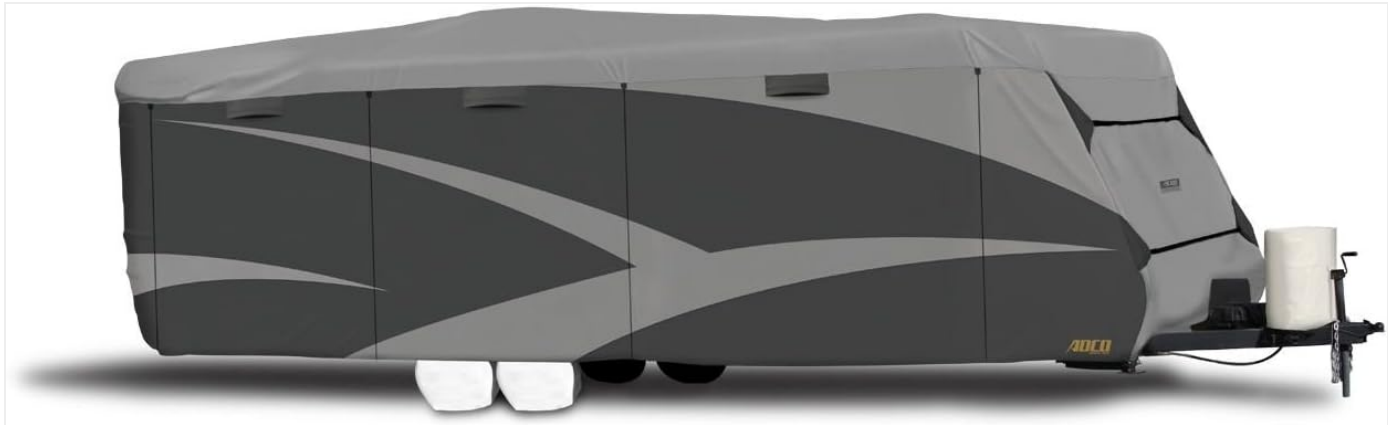

# ADCO 52243 Designer Series SFS Aqua Shed Travel Trailer RV Cover Instruction Manual

Model: 52243 (Fits 24'1" - 26' Travel Trailers)

## INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your ADCO 52243 Designer Series SFS Aqua Shed Travel Trailer RV Cover. This cover is designed for travel trailers measuring 24'1" to 26' in length, offering protection in moderate climates with high moisture.

## SAFETY INFORMATION

- Ensure the RV is parked on a level surface and stabilized before installation.
- Use a sturdy ladder for safe access to the RV roof during installation.
- Avoid installing the cover in high winds.
- Inspect the RV for sharp edges or protrusions that could damage the cover. Cover these areas with padding if necessary.
- Always work with a partner when installing or removing the cover to ensure safety and ease of handling.

## PACKAGE CONTENTS

---

Verify that all components are present before beginning installation:

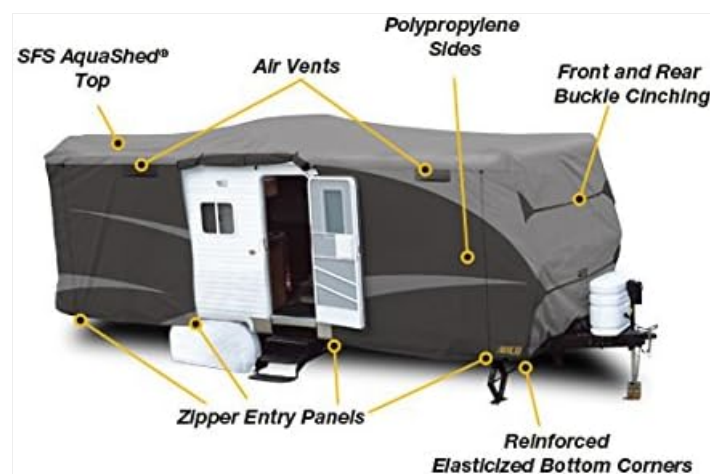
- ADCO Designer Series SFS Aqua Shed RV Cover
- Storage bag
- Rain gutter spout protectors (4 units)
- Ladder cap
- Extra adhesive reinforcement material
- Weighted buckle toss-under straps (2 units)

## SETUP AND INSTALLATION

---

Proper installation ensures maximum protection and extends the life of your RV cover. It is recommended to have at least two people for installation.

1. **Prepare the RV:** Clean the RV thoroughly to prevent dirt and debris from scratching the surface under the cover. Identify any sharp edges, such as ladder rungs, antenna mounts, or rain gutters. Use the provided rain gutter spout protectors and ladder cap. For other sharp points, use additional padding (e.g., foam, old towels) to prevent tears.
2. **Unfold the Cover:** Lay the cover out on the ground next to your RV. Identify the front and rear of the cover (it is typically labeled).
3. **Position on Roof:** With a partner, carefully lift the rolled-up cover onto the roof of the RV. Position it so the front of the cover aligns with the front of the RV.
4. **Unroll and Drape:** Slowly unroll the cover from front to back, allowing it to drape over the sides of the RV. Ensure it is centered. Avoid dragging the cover across sharp edges.
5. **Secure the Front and Rear:** Pull the front and rear panels down. Use the integrated buckle cinching system at the front and rear to remove slack.
6. **Connect Underbelly Straps:** Use the weighted buckle toss-under straps to connect the buckles on one side of the RV to the corresponding buckles on the other side, underneath the RV. Gently tighten these straps to secure the cover. Do not overtighten.
7. **Adjust for Fit:** Make minor adjustments to ensure the cover is evenly distributed and snug, but not overly tight, around the entire RV.

## OPERATING THE COVER

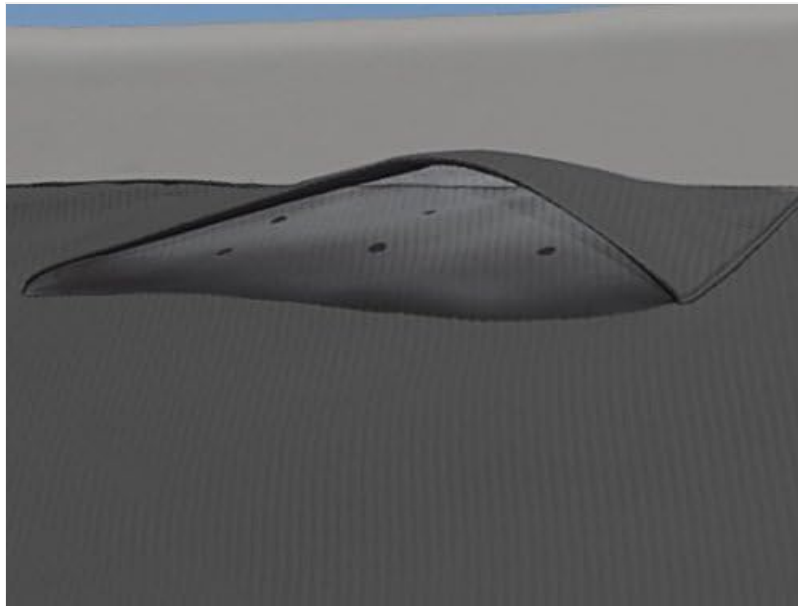
---

The ADCO RV cover is designed with user convenience in mind, allowing access to your RV even when covered.

- **Zipper Entry Panels:** The cover features multiple passenger-side zipper entry doors. These allow easy access to the RV interior without removing the entire cover. Simply unzip the desired panel and roll it up or secure it to the side.
- **Air Vents:** Built-in vents allow air to escape, reducing condensation and preventing billowing in moderate winds. These vents are integrated into the design and require no manual operation.
- **Cinching System:** The front, rear, and bottom buckle cinching system helps maintain a snug fit. Periodically check and adjust the tension of these straps to ensure the cover remains secure, especially after strong winds.

## MAINTENANCE

---

The ADCO Designer Series SFS Aqua Shed RV Cover is designed for durability and minimal maintenance. Regular inspection and proper care will extend its lifespan.

- **Cleaning:** The SFS Aqua Shed material is designed to repel water and allow air to penetrate, reducing the need for frequent cleaning. If cleaning is necessary, gently brush off loose dirt. For stubborn spots, use mild soap and water, then rinse thoroughly. Allow the cover to air dry completely before folding and storing.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect the cover for any signs of wear, tears, or damage, especially after severe weather. Use the provided extra adhesive reinforcement material for minor repairs.
- **Storage:** When not in use, ensure the cover is clean and completely dry. Fold it neatly and store it in the provided storage bag in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and pests.
- **Sharp Edges:** Continuously monitor any potential abrasion points on your RV (e.g., sharp corners, ladder, antenna) that could rub against the cover, especially in windy conditions. Re-pad these areas as needed.

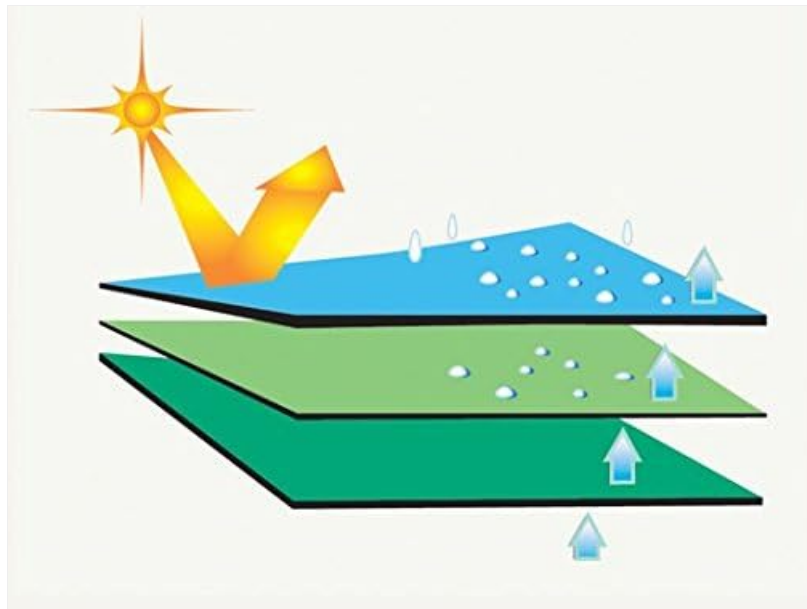


Image: A diagram explaining the multi-layer SFS Aqua Shed fabric, highlighting its water-repellent and breathable properties.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Cover tearing or fraying prematurely.	Sharp edges on RV, insufficient padding, extreme wind abrasion, improper installation.	Ensure all sharp points on the RV are adequately padded. Check strap tension; avoid overtightening. Use provided repair patches for minor tears.
Cover billowing or flapping in wind.	Straps are not sufficiently tightened, cover is too loose for the RV size.	Adjust and tighten all buckle straps (front, rear, and underbelly) to achieve a snug fit. Ensure the cover size matches your RV's length.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Condensation or moisture under the cover.	High humidity, insufficient airflow.	The SFS Aqua Shed material is breathable, but in very high humidity, some condensation can occur. Ensure vents are clear. Consider airing out the RV periodically if stored for extended periods in humid conditions.
Difficulty installing the cover.	Attempting installation alone, incorrect folding, windy conditions.	Always install with at least one other person. Ensure the cover is correctly oriented (front/rear) before lifting onto the RV. Avoid installation during strong winds.
