Product Overview

The Plantronics Voyager Legend is an intelligent Bluetooth headset designed for intuitive use with universal smartphones. It features Smart Sensor technology, precision audio, caller announce, and voice commands for a seamless communication experience.

Key Features:

- **Smart Call Routing:** Automatically directs calls to the headset when worn.

Setup Guide

1. Charging the Headset

Before first use, fully charge your headset. Connect the magnetic charging cable to the headset and a USB power source. The indicator light will show charging status.

2. Pairing with Your Device

1. Turn on the headset by sliding the power switch.
2. Activate Bluetooth on your smartphone or other compatible device.
3. Put the headset into pairing mode. (Refer to the specific pairing instructions that came with your headset, usually by holding the call button until the LED flashes red/blue).
4. Select "Plantronics Voyager Legend" from the list of available Bluetooth devices on your phone.
5. Once paired, the headset will confirm the connection.

3. Wearing the Headset

The headset is designed to be worn over the ear. Adjust the ear hook and select an ear tip from the kit that provides a comfortable and secure fit. The microphone boom should point towards your mouth.

Operating Instructions

Smart Sensor Technology

The headset features Smart Sensor technology. When you put on the headset, it automatically answers an incoming call. If you are already wearing it, it will announce the caller's name (if supported by your phone) and prompt you to say "answer" or "ignore".

Voice Commands

Tap the voice command button (usually located on the microphone boom or side of the headset) to activate voice commands. You can then ask for battery level, connection status, or other supported commands.

Call Management

- **Answer/End Call:** Press the Call button once.
- **Ignore Call:** Say "ignore" when prompted, or press and hold the Call button for 2 seconds.
- **Redial Last Number:** Double-tap the Call button.

Volume Control

Use the volume up/down buttons located on the headset to adjust call and media volume.

Maintenance

Proper care will extend the life of your Plantronics Voyager Legend headset.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the headset with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or immerse in water.
- **Storage:** Store the headset in a cool, dry place away from extreme temperatures and direct sunlight.
- **Battery Care:** To maintain battery health, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. Charge the headset regularly, even if not in use for extended periods.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Solution
Headset does not turn on.	Ensure the headset is fully charged. Connect it to the charger and wait a few minutes before attempting to turn it on.

Problem	Solution
Cannot pair with my device.	Make sure the headset is in pairing mode (LED flashing). Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your device. Delete "Plantronics Voyager Legend" from your device's Bluetooth list and try pairing again. Restart both the headset and your device.
Poor audio quality or no sound.	Check the volume levels on both the headset and your connected device. Ensure the headset is within range of your device (typically up to 33 feet or 10 meters). Move away from sources of interference (e.g., Wi-Fi routers, microwaves). Re-pair the headset with your device.
Voice commands not responding.	Ensure you are speaking clearly and directly into the microphone. Check if the voice command feature is enabled on your device.
