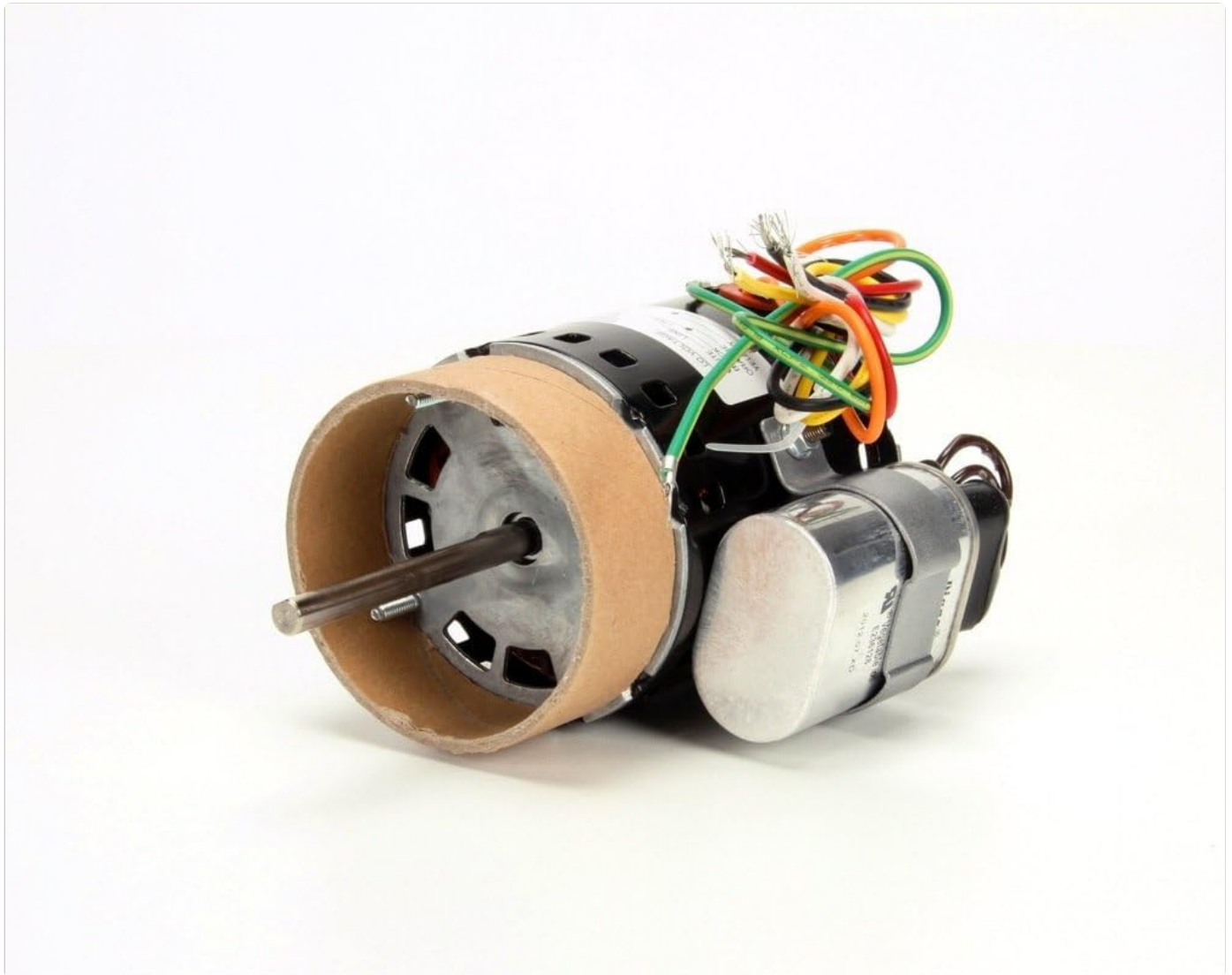

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Motor does not start	No power supply; Loose wiring; Faulty capacitor; Overload protection tripped; Motor failure.	Check power supply and circuit breaker. Verify all electrical connections. Inspect capacitor for damage (replace if necessary). Reset overload protector. If motor is faulty, replacement is required.
Motor overheats	Insufficient ventilation; Excessive load; Low voltage; Bearing failure.	Ensure ventilation openings are clear. Reduce load on equipment if possible. Verify correct voltage supply. If bearings are failing, motor replacement may be necessary.
Unusual noise or vibration	Loose mounting; Worn bearings; Obstruction in fan/shaft; Imbalance.	Tighten mounting bolts. Inspect bearings for wear. Check for obstructions around the shaft or fan. If imbalance or bearing wear is significant, professional service or replacement is advised.
