1. INTRODUCTION

The Honeywell RET97E5D1005/U Wi-Fi Programmable Thermostat provides advanced control over your home's heating and cooling system. This device allows for remote access and management via smartphone or computer, offering convenience and energy efficiency. This manual provides essential information for installation, operation, and troubleshooting to ensure optimal performance of your thermostat.

2. KEY FEATURES

- **Wi-Fi Enabled:** Allows remote access and control via smartphone or computer.

- **Smartphone App:** Free app available for iPhone, iPad, and Android operating systems.
- **Universal Compatibility:** Designed to work with most heating and cooling systems.
- **Programmable Schedule:** Pre-programmed with an energy-saving schedule, configurable to meet various requirements.

3. INSTALLATION GUIDE

3.1 Wiring Requirements

Proper installation requires a common wire (C-wire) to provide continuous power to the thermostat, as the Wi-Fi radio requires constant power and cannot operate on batteries alone. If your existing thermostat wiring does not include a C-wire, you may need to run a new cable or use an add-a-wire accessory.

- **Standard 2-Wire Systems (Heat-Only):** For systems without a common terminal on the controller, a separate 24VAC transformer can be used. Connect the transformer's positive wire to Rc and the common wire to C on the thermostat's wall plate. Ensure the pre-installed jumper between R and Rc is removed if using a separate transformer.

- **C-Wire Connection:** Connect the C-wire from your furnace or HVAC system to the C terminal on the thermostat's wall plate.

3.2 Physical Installation

Mount the thermostat's wall plate to a suitable location on your wall, ensuring all wires are securely connected to their respective terminals. Once the wall plate is installed, carefully attach the thermostat body to the backing plate.

4. WI-FI SETUP AND REGISTRATION

4.1 Initial Wi-Fi Connection

To complete the initial setup, you will need a device with Wi-Fi capabilities (e.g., laptop, smartphone, tablet) and a web browser. A compatible 802.11b/g/n wireless router is also required. The process involves connecting your device to the thermostat's temporary Wi-Fi signal, then linking the thermostat to your permanent home Wi-Fi network.

4.2 Troubleshooting Wi-Fi Connection (Error 200)

If you encounter an "ERROR,200" message on your device during the Wi-Fi setup process, this typically indicates an unsupported web browser. While you may be able to connect to the thermostat's temporary Wi-Fi signal, the linking process to your home network may fail. It is recommended to use a widely supported browser such as **Google Chrome** for the setup. Switching browsers often resolves this issue.

4.3 Thermostat Registration

After successfully connecting the thermostat to your home Wi-Fi, you must register it on the Honeywell Total Comfort Connect website to enable remote access. This involves creating an account (if you don't have one) and adding your thermostat as a new device.

- Locate the MAC ID and the related 4-digit code printed on the back of your thermostat unit.
- Enter these details into the "new device" section on the Honeywell Total Comfort Connect website.

4.4 Troubleshooting Registration

If registration is rejected without a specific error code, or if there's a generic statement about the thermostat's Wi-Fi connection being down (even if the Wi-Fi icon shows a strong signal), try the following:

- Gently pull the thermostat body off its backing plate for approximately 30 seconds.
- Re-install the thermostat body onto the backing plate. This brief power cycle can refresh the connection without losing settings.
- Return to the Honeywell Total Comfort Connect interface and re-enter the MAC ID and 4-digit code to attempt registration again.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Basic Controls

The thermostat features physical buttons for direct control:

- **System Mode:** Switch between Cool, Heat, and Off.
- **Fan Control:** Select Off or Auto.
- **Temperature Adjustment:** Use the up/down arrows to set the desired temperature.
- **Hold Function:** Activate permanent or temporary temperature holds.

5.2 Programming Schedule

The thermostat comes with a pre-programmed energy-saving schedule. You can customize this schedule

to fit your specific needs and preferences directly on the unit or through the smartphone app/web interface.

5.3 Remote Control via App/Web

Once registered, you can remotely view and control your home's temperature from anywhere using the free smartphone app or the Honeywell Total Comfort Connect website. This allows you to adjust settings, change schedules, and monitor your system's status.

5.4 Smart Response Technology

This feature allows the thermostat to learn how long it takes your heating and cooling system to reach programmed temperatures. It then automatically adjusts the start time to ensure your home is comfortable at your scheduled times.

5.5 Alerts and Notifications

The thermostat can send alerts to your connected devices for events such as high/low temperature deviations or loss of connection to your Wi-Fi network, keeping you informed about your home's climate status.

6. MAINTENANCE

The Honeywell RET97E5D1005/U thermostat requires minimal maintenance. Keep the display clean with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or solvents. The real-time clock feature ensures the time is maintained during power failures and automatically updates for daylight saving time (if enabled).

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

7.1 Wi-Fi Connection Issues

- **"ERROR,200" during Wi-Fi Setup:** This error indicates an unsupported web browser. Use Google Chrome for the Wi-Fi setup process.
- **Thermostat Not Connecting to Home Wi-Fi:** Ensure your router is compatible (802.11b/g/n). Verify your Wi-Fi password. Try power cycling your router and the thermostat.

7.2 Registration Problems

- **Registration Rejected:** If the Honeywell Total Comfort Connect website rejects registration, even with correct MAC ID and 4-digit code, try briefly removing the thermostat body from its wall plate for 30 seconds, then reattaching it. This can resolve connection timing issues.
- **Website Access Issues:** If the Honeywell Total Comfort Connect website is unresponsive, it may be undergoing maintenance. Try again after some time.

7.3 Technical Support

When contacting technical support, be aware that there might be long silent gaps before menu options are presented. Ensure you wait for the options to appear. Audio quality may vary. Have your model number and any error codes ready.
