# George Foreman GRP3102SBB 6 Serving Removable Plate Grill Instruction Manual

## INTRODUCTION

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This instruction manual provides important information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your George Foreman GRP3102SBB 6 Serving Removable Plate Grill. Please read this manual thoroughly before first use and retain it for future reference.

The George Foreman GRP3102SBB is designed to make lean meals with less time and hassle. It features a 100 Sq. In. grilling surface with a patented sloped design and nonstick coating to help drain fat. The removable plates and dishwasher-safe drip tray simplify cleanup. A floating hinge allows for grilling thicker foods and melting cheese.

## IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

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When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed, including the following:

- Read all instructions.
- Do not touch hot surfaces. Use handles or knobs.
- To protect against electrical shock, do not immerse cord, plugs, or appliance in water or other liquid.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug or after the appliance malfunctions, or has been damaged in any manner. Return appliance to the nearest authorized service facility for examination, repair, or adjustment.
- The use of accessory attachments not recommended by the appliance manufacturer may cause injuries.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Extreme caution must be used when moving an appliance containing hot oil or other hot liquids.

- Always attach plug to appliance first, then plug cord into the wall outlet. To disconnect, turn any control to "off", then remove plug from wall outlet.
- Do not use appliance for other than intended use.
- This appliance has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other). To reduce the risk of electric shock, this plug is intended to fit into a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully into the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Do not attempt to modify the plug in any way.

## PARTS AND FEATURES

1. Grill Handle
2. Top Grill Plate (Removable)

## SETUP AND FIRST USE

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### Before First Use:

1. Remove all packing materials, stickers, and plastic bands from the grill.
2. Wash the removable grill plates and drip tray in warm, soapy water. Rinse and dry thoroughly.
3. Wipe the exterior of the grill with a damp cloth and dry thoroughly.
4. Ensure the grill plates are securely locked into place before use.

### Positioning the Grill:

- Place the grill on a stable, heat-resistant, and level surface.
- Ensure there is adequate space around the grill for ventilation.
- Position the drip tray directly under the front of the grill to collect excess fat and liquids.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

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### Preheating the Grill:

1. Ensure the drip tray is in place.
2. Close the grill lid.
3. Plug the power cord into a standard electrical outlet. The red power indicator light will illuminate.
4. Set the Temperature Control Dial to your desired temperature setting (e.g., High for most meats).
5. Allow the grill to preheat. The green ready indicator light will illuminate when the grill has reached the set temperature. This typically takes 5-7 minutes.

### Grilling Food:

1. Once the green ready light is on, carefully open the grill.
2. Place food evenly on the bottom grill plate. Do not overload the grill.
3. Close the lid. The floating hinge allows the top plate to adjust to the thickness of the food.
4. Set the Timer Control Dial to the desired cooking time. The grill will begin cooking.
5. Cook until food is done to your preference. Refer to cooking charts for approximate times.
6. When cooking is complete, the timer will sound, and the grill will turn off.
7. Carefully remove food using heat-resistant plastic or wooden utensils. Do not use metal utensils as they can damage the nonstick coating.
8. Unplug the grill from the outlet after use.

### Tips for Best Results:

- For best results, preheat the grill fully before adding food.
- The sloped design helps drain fat into the drip tray, promoting healthier cooking.
- Avoid piercing food with metal forks or knives to preserve the nonstick surface.
- Always ensure the drip tray is in place to catch grease.

## CARE AND MAINTENANCE

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### Cleaning Your Grill:

1. Always unplug the grill and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.
2. Remove the grill plates by pressing the plate release buttons and lifting them off.
3. Empty the drip tray and wash it with warm, soapy water.
4. The removable grill plates are dishwasher safe. Alternatively, they can be washed by hand with warm, soapy water and a non-abrasive sponge.
5. For stubborn residue, soak the plates in warm, soapy water for a few minutes before cleaning.
6. Wipe the exterior of the grill base with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the base in water or any other liquid.
7. Do not use abrasive cleaners or scouring pads on any part of the grill, especially the nonstick surfaces.
8. Ensure all parts are thoroughly dry before reassembling or storing the grill.

### Storage:

- Store the grill in a clean, dry place.
- The grill can be stored vertically to save counter space.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

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Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Grill does not turn on.	Not plugged in; power outlet not working; timer not set.	Ensure grill is securely plugged into a working outlet. Turn the Timer Control Dial to a desired cooking time to activate the grill.
Food sticking to grill plates.	Nonstick coating worn; grill not preheated sufficiently; food not suitable for grilling without oil.	Ensure grill is fully preheated (green light on). Lightly spray cooking oil on plates before adding food. If coating is severely worn, consider replacement plates or appliance.
Grill not heating properly.	Temperature dial set too low; grill plates not properly installed.	Adjust Temperature Control Dial to a higher setting. Ensure grill plates are securely clicked into place.
Excessive smoke.	Grease buildup on plates; very fatty food; drip tray full.	Clean grill plates thoroughly after each use. Ensure drip tray is empty before cooking. Trim excess fat from food.
