1. Introduction

4. SETUP

4.1 Battery Installation

- 1. Locate the battery compartment on the underside of the scale.
- 2. Open the battery compartment cover.
- 3. Insert the required batteries (e.g., 2 x AAA, check compartment for specific type) ensuring correct polarity (+/-).
- 4. Close the battery compartment cover securely.

4.2 Scale Placement

Place the scale on a hard, flat, and stable surface, such as a floor or sturdy table. Avoid carpets or uneven surfaces, as these can affect accuracy.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Turning On the Scale

Press the **ON/OFF** button. The display will show "0.000 kg" (or selected unit) when ready for use.

5.2 Selecting Units of Measurement

If your scale supports multiple units (e.g., kg, lb, st), press the **UNIT** button (if available) to cycle through the options until your desired unit is displayed.

5.3 Weighing an Infant

- 1. Turn on the scale and wait for "0.000 kg" to appear.

5.4 Tare Function (Zeroing)

The Tare function allows you to subtract the weight of a blanket or diaper before weighing the baby.

- 1. Turn on the scale.
- 2. Place the blanket or towel on the weighing platform.
- 3. Press the **TARE** button (if available). The display will reset to "0.000 kg".
- 4. Now, place the infant on the blanket. The display will show only the infant's weight.

5.5 Turning Off the Scale

Press and hold the **ON/OFF** button until the display turns off. The scale may also feature an automatic shut-off function after a period of inactivity to conserve battery life.

6. Maintenance and Care

- Clean the scale with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- Do not immerse the scale in water or expose it to excessive moisture.
- Store the scale in a dry place at room temperature.
- Remove batteries if the scale is not used for an extended period to prevent leakage.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Display shows "Lo"	Low battery power.	Replace batteries with new ones.
Display shows "Err" or "O-Ld"	Scale overloaded or unstable surface.	Ensure weight is within maximum capacity. Place scale on a firm, flat surface.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Inaccurate readings	Unstable surface, movement during weighing, or scale not zeroed.	Place scale on a stable surface. Ensure infant is still. Use Tare function if needed. Recalibrate if possible (refer to specific model instructions if available).
Scale does not turn on	Batteries incorrectly inserted or depleted.	Check battery polarity. Replace batteries.




